FISHERIES ACT 1905 PROHIBITION ON USE OF SET NETS (CAPE NATURALISTE TO CAPEL RIVER) NOTICE 1990

Made by the Minister under Sections 9 and 11.

Citation

1. This notice may be cited as the *Prohibition On Use of Set Nets (Cape Naturaliste* to Capel River) Notice 1990.

Prohibition on taking fish

2. Subject to clause 3 no person shall take any fish by means of set nets in the waters specified in the Schedule.

Use of nets to take crabs

A person may take crabs by means of drop nets in the waters specified in the Schedule.

Revocation

4. The notice dated 3 April 1978 published in the *Gazette* of 7 April 1978 is cancelled.

Schedule

All waters of the Indian Ocean within 400 metres of the high water mark between the northernmost point of Cape Naturaliste and the mouth of the Capel River. Dated 2 November 1990.
