SUPPORTING COMMUNITIES FORUM 2021 - 2022 – PRIORITIES

Priority 1 – Implementation of the 10-Year Strategy on Homelessness 2020-2030

Objective:

- To provide advice and support implementation of *All Paths Lead to a Home: Western Australia's 10-Year Strategy on Homelessness 2020 – 2030*.
- To adopt a whole-of-community approach to deliver appropriate, flexible and culturally responsive housing options and services that respond to the diverse needs of vulnerable Western Australians.
- To consult closely with relevant community sector and government agencies to ensure alignment with intersecting strategies and priorities, recognising that people at risk of or experiencing homelessness access a range of support and services delivered by multiple agencies.
- To oversee progress reporting and implementation ensuring shared responsibility, accountability and delivery of actions.

Key questions:

1. What can be learnt about shared responsibility across portfolio areas and sectors, and how can joint implementation processes be improved to support the Strategy's success?
2. How can ongoing engagement with key stakeholders and partnerships, particularly with Aboriginal communities and organisations, be supported to strengthen implementation of the Strategy?
3. How can we adapt our responses in light of changes in needs and demand as a result of the impact of COVID-19?
4. How will the outcomes measurement framework for the Strategy and recently developed Community Services Outcome Measurement Framework be aligned, as part of the monitoring and reporting of the outcomes of the Strategy?
5. How regularly should public-facing reporting be undertaken and what information should be made publicly available?

Deliverables:

- Annual progress update on: Strategy implementation; key achievements; success stories; lessons learned; and areas for improvement; and
- Oversight of delivery of actions committed to across government and the community sector in the Action Plan 2020-2025.
