TEMPORARY EXEMPTION OF CLASS OF PERSONS (NO 2) UNDER PARAGRAPH 36 OF THE FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES WORKER (RESTRICTIONS ON ACCESS) DIRECTIONS (NO 2)

- I, Dr Andrew Robertson, Chief Health Officer, for the purposes of paragraph 36 of the Fire and Emergency Services Worker (Restrictions on Access) Directions (No 2) (the Directions), made under sections 157(1)(e), 157(1)(k), 180 and 190(1)(p) of the *Public Health Act 2016*, hereby approve a temporary exemption for the class of persons listed in Schedule 1 of this instrument:
 - a. from the requirements of paragraph 6(a) of the Directions from the period commencing on 12:01am on 1 January 2022 and ending on 12:01am on 10 February 2022.
 - b. from the requirements of paragraph 6(b) of the Directions from the period commencing on 12:01am on 1 February 2022 and ending on 12:01am on 10 April 2022.
- 2. The instrument titled "Temporary Exemption of Class of Persons Under Paragraph 36 of the Fire and Emergency Services Worker (Restrictions on Access) Direction (No 2)" dated 17 December 2021 is hereby revoked.
- 3. This instrument shall take effect upon signing and shall remain in force until otherwise amended or revoked.
