# Determination No. 1 of 2022

- 1. Cancel Determination of Areas Closed to Fishing for Scallops in the Shark Bay Scallop Managed Fishery: Determination No. 1 of 2019, dated 30 April 2019.
- 2. Prohibit fishing for scallops in all parts of the Fishery from the date of gazettal of the Notice advising that I have made *Determination of Areas Closed to Fishing for Scallops in the Shark Bay Scallop Managed Fishery: Determination No. 1 of 2022*, to 0800 hours on 1 June 2025.
