

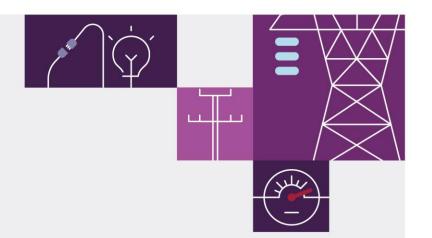

Purpose

AEMO must publish, together with a final WEM Procedure, a summary of submissions received and the response of AEMO to issues raised in those submissions, with respect to amendments to Procedures required to be developed under:

- For clause 1.36.7(b) Wholesale Electricity Market Amendment (Tranche 1 Amendments) Rules 2020.
- For clause 1.43.7(b) Wholesale Electricity Market Amendment (Tranche 2 and 3 Amendments) Rules 2020.
- For clause 1.43A.6 Wholesale Electricity Market Amendment (Tranche 5 Amendments) Rules 2021.

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Submissions and AEMO's Response

The following written submissions were received as part of AEMO's stakeholder consultation.

2.1.2	Stakeholder recommended AEMO amend paragraph 2.1.2 to include the word "promptly" so that obligation to publish notice to participants is not unduly delayed	AEMO has amended the WEM Procedure and has included "promptly", as suggested.
3.1.	Stakeholder advised that it seems that the paragraphs are not chronological, and the process would be more logical if the steps were sequential in terms of the high level steps: 1. AEMO issues Reserve Capacity a. AEO may provide notice of Reserve Capacity in WEMS (3.4.1) 2. AEMO opens WEMS for capacity trades (3.1.2) a. Trades must be lodged via WEMS unless (3.1.9)	AEMO agrees that it may be clearer to structure the process in chronological order. AEMO has amended paragraph 3 to include headings which are sequential to the Bilateral Trade Declaration process.
