

Information Sheet Establishing needs and opportunities and evaluating the impact of the Early Years Network

Identifying needs and opportunities for an Early Years Network provides the basis for decision making on projects and actions. Evaluating the impact means monitoring and measuring the effectiveness of the action plan.

In order to establish the needs and opportunities and evaluate the impact of Early Years Networks, analysis of data is required. Data can include:

- 1. **Quantitative data:** Gathering information in the form of countable data, such as pre-school attendance rates, number of families using local toy library, or ratings for a service.
- Qualitative data: Gathering information in the form of descriptions. Open-ended
 questions can be a valuable tool. Examples of qualitative data include parent
 feedback about what works well for them, barriers to local services and reasons for
 their choices.

Data can be obtained from:

- analysing existing data
- undertaking questionnaires/surveys
- undertaking interviews
- undertaking focus groups
- obtaining story dialogue
- informal discussions.

Depending on the purpose of the information being collected, it may be suitable to consult:

parents, carers and grandcarers



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- children
- child development services
- community development sector
- community members or business/political leaders.

When establishing needs and opportunities or evaluating an action, it is important to understand:

- What is the issue?
- What is the proposed program?
- Who are the participants?
- What are the goals?
- What is our strategy?
- How will our strategy contribute to achieving the goals?

This will guide the way that the outcomes are measured. It is useful to consider:

- What would success look like?
- How can we measure success?
- How much did we do?
- How well did we do it?
- Did anything change?
- What works and why? What does not work and why?
- How have things changed over time and for whom?
- Are we achieving our vision and mission? Are we achieving our action plan?
