
Separate counting rules that best illustrate the work of the court is utilised for each statistic. Please read the counting rules on each page to help interpret the data.




















Civil Finalisations by Trial



Appendix One--Definitions

The following are definitions of case types that are used within the Magistrates Court.

Case Types

Matters lodged within the Magistrates Court are classified by case type. The following definitions specify the differences between the case types used.

Appeals and Reviews

Applications seeking the review of a decision of a Justice of the Peace or a registrar.

Auctioneer's Licence

Application seeking a license to facilitate an auction under the *Auction Sales Act* 1973.

Consumer/Trader Claim

Application under the *Magistrates Court (Civil Proceedings) Act 2004* seeking a remedy in a dispute between a consumer and a trader.

Criminal Profits Confiscation Act

Applications made by the State under the *Criminal Property Confiscation Act 2000*, ordering confiscation in certain circumstances of property acquired as a result of criminal activity and property used for criminal activity.

Disposal of Uncollected Goods

Applications made under the *Disposal of Uncollected Goods Act 1970* seeking the removal of goods left on premises.

Extraordinary Driver's Licence

Application under the *Road Traffic Act 1974* seeking permission to hold an Extraordinary Driver's Licence when a driver has been disqualified from holding or obtaining a driver's licence. A successful application allows someone who has been disqualified from driving to drive in certain circumstances.

General Application

An application under the *Magistrates Court (Civil Proceedings) Act 2004* that is of a non-specific nature.

General Procedure Claim

Application under the *Magistrates Court (Civil Proceedings) Act 2004* seeking a remedy in a dispute where the monetary value of the remedy sought is less than \$75,000.

Minor Cases Procedure Claim

Application under the *Magistrates Court (Civil Proceedings) Act 2004* seeking a remedy in a dispute where the monetary value of the remedy sought is less than \$10,000.

Prohibited Behaviour Order

An application by the State under the *Prohibited Behaviour Orders Act 2010* seeking the prohibition of recurrent criminal activity which is made following certain criminal convictions. When a prohibited behaviour order is made it specifies certain restrictions on a person that aim to prevent that person from engaging in future anti-social offending.

Recovery Of Possession Of Land

An application under the *Magistrates Court (Civil Proceedings) Act 2004* seeking to recover possession of real property (land).

Registration Of Orders

Applications seeking the registration of orders made by other jurisdictions (either interstate or other jurisdicitons in Western Australia) within the Magistrates Court of Western Australian jurisdiction.

Residential Tenancies

A general application under the *Residential Tenancies Act 1987* seeking the intervention of the Court in disputes between tenants and landlords or between co-tenants.

Restraining Of Goods/Property Order

Applications made under the *Restraint of Debtors Act 1984* seeking an order from the court that will restrain the transfer or removal from the state of property until a debt is paid.

Restraining Order

An application under the *Restraining Orders Act 1997* seeking an order restraining the person who is bound from from either: committing an act of abuse, breaching the peace, causing fear, damaging property or intimidating another person. Orders can also be made under the *Prostitution Act 2000* restraining a person from being in or near a specified place or engaging in specified behaviours.

Restraint Of Debtors Action

Applications made under the *Restraint of Debtors Act 1984* seeking an order from the court that will restrain a debtor from leaving the State until a debt is paid.

Revocation of Disqualification Notice

An application under the *Road Traffic Act 1974* seeking to revoke a disqualification from holding or obtaining a driver's licence issued by a police officer within ten days of the commission of an offence.

Under Age Marriage

An application seeking the permission of the Court to allow a marriage between two applicants, where one is under 18 years of age.
