



Payroll Tax - Declaration of Indigenous Wages Paid in WA

About this form:

Pay-Roll Tax (Indigenous Wages) Rebate Act 2012 Pay-Roll Tax (Indigenous Wages) Rebate Regulations 2016

For the Commissioner of State Revenue (the Commissioner) to determine eligibility for, and the amount of, any rebate of payroll tax paid in relation to wages paid to new indigenous employees:

- submit this completed declaration form and all required documentation and
- keep records of all supporting documentation.

Application for the Indigenous Wages Rebate can be made by attaching this form to a Web Enquiry through <u>www.osr.wa.gov.au/PayrollEnquiry</u> (select the 'Indigenous Wages Declaration' sub-category). Upon receipt, RevenueWA will determine the eligibility for the rebate and, if eligible, the amount of the rebate.

The Indigenous Wages Rebate is payable to eligible employers in respect of wages paid to eligible employees as set out in the <u>Pay-roll Tax (Indigenous Wages) Rebate Act 2012</u> and <u>Pay-Roll Tax (Indigenous Wages) Rebate Regulations 2016</u>. Before completing this declaration it is recommended that you read the information about the <u>Indigenous Wages Rebate</u> on the website.

All eligible indigenous wages paid within a financial year must be declared on this form. However, please note the Indigenous Wages Rebate is a rebate of payroll tax that has already been paid by an employer in respect of eligible indigenous wages that have been declared during the financial year as taxable wages.
