Background	On 2 February 2007 DEC classified the above site as <i>remediated for restricted use.</i> The appellant is the owner of the site and is objecting to the site classification for various reasons as detailed in the appellant's letter of appeal dated 14 February 2007.
Committee's decision	The appeal is dismissed. The existing classification is affirmed.
Reasons for decision	<ul> <li>The appellant claims that <ul> <li>the site was remediated by the State in 1998,</li> <li>only a small area of the site was not sampled,</li> <li>the chance of this being contaminated is remote, and</li> <li>the EPA advised the appellant in 1999 that remediation was complete.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The remediation of the site was limited, as it was infeasible to sample or remediate the soil below the incinerator. Rather, with the agreement of the appellant, a containment cell was</li> </ul>
	constructed to retain any contamination below the incinerator and ensure, as far as possible that there were no ground water impacts. The appellant has provided no evidence to indicate that the soil within the containment cell below the incinerator is not contaminated. The classification remains appropriate.
