The Council considered the following matters:

Privacy and Responsible Information Sharing Legislation

The Council were briefed on the progress of the Privacy and Responsible Information Sharing (PRIS) legislation. This legislation will reform personal privacy protections and accountability of information sharing within Government, whilst supporting opportunities for the Government to responsibly use data to deliver more effective, efficient, and seamless services to better support the Western Australian community.

ServiceWA App

The Council were presented with an update on the ServiceWA App functionalities and the WA Government's Digital Transformation journey. The Council were informed on the services that were onboarded in 2022, such as FuelWatch and Weather Stations, and proposed services for implementation in the future.
