The parties request the Electricity Review Board to make the following orders by consent of the parties:

The Electricity Review Board orders and directs that:

1. Orders 6 to 16 of the orders made by the Board on 22 November 2022 be replaced as follows:

Evidence

6. By 4.00pm on 30 March 2023, the Applicant file any evidence, including expert evidence, on which it intends to rely at the hearing on penalties and other relief.
7. By 4.00pm on 11 May 2023, the Respondent file any evidence, including expert evidence, on which it intends to rely at the hearing on penalties and other relief.
8. By 4.00pm on 29 May 2023, the Applicant file and serve any responsive evidence.

9. By 4.00pm on 6 June 2023, the parties notify each other of any documents they intend to tender at the hearing.

Objections to evidence

10. By 4.00pm on 12 June 2023, the parties provide to each other any objections to evidence (including documents proposed to be tendered).
11. By 4.00pm on 15 June 2023, the parties provide to each other responses to any objections to evidence.
12. By 4.00pm on 19 June 2023, the parties file documents that set out any objections to evidence that are pressed and responses to those objections.

Hearing book

13. By 4.00pm on 20 June 2023, the Applicant deliver to the Board and the Respondent a hearing book, the content and format of which will be agreed between the parties.

Submissions

14. By 4.00pm on 27 June 2023, the Applicant file and serve a written outline of submissions.
15. By 4.00pm on 18 July 2023, the Respondent file and serve a written outline of submissions.

Hearing

16. The issues of penalties and other relief be listed for hearing commencing on a date after 25 July 2023 after conferral with the parties on an estimate of 1 day.
