AMENDED STRUCTURE PLAN – NORTH STONEVILLE STRUCTURE PLAN 34

The Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage (the Department), on behalf of the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) has received an amended North Stoneville Structure Plan (amended structure plan) in accordance with State Administrative Tribunal Orders made on 4 November 2022. The original structure plan was refused by the WAPC on 14 July 2020. Further information and background to the amended structure plan is available online at: <https://www.wa.gov.au/north-stoneville>

The amended structure plan proposes a new townsite within the Perth Hills, providing for approximately 1,000 new dwellings and associated amenities, including recreation and conservation open space areas, and roads and services infrastructure over an approximate area of 535 hectares.
