## **Introduction**

Each year the State Records Office of WA (SRO) publishes an online Guide to State Cabinet records which have been released from their 30-year restriction access period in the previous calendar year. This year's Guide introduces the records of Cabinet minutes and decisions from 1990.

State Cabinet records are historically significant documents which reveal the decisions made by the government of the day. These unique records are the primary source documents for information about the issues raised at Cabinet meetings. This online Guide is intended to assist the Western Australian community with access to these records.

This online Guide also provides an overview of Western Australian state issues in 1990, as well as highlighting a few of the more prominent national and international news events of that year for context. A list of the topics and subjects discussed at each meeting of State Cabinet in 1990 is provided in this Guide to assist with further research into the records. This list includes a link to the SRO's online catalogue to enable the public to view relevant State Cabinet records online.

Unlike the release of Cabinet papers at the Commonwealth level, where records comprising more sensitive information can be embargoed beyond the restriction access period for the remaining records, all State Cabinet records for Western Australia are released for public access 30 years after the records are created.

This year (2021) the Guide to the 1990 State Cabinet Records has been produced with the assistance of Ms Mulan Wai, a student from the University of Western Australia during a McCusker Centre for Citizenship internship at the SRO. Ms Wai researched the 1990 State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions, and an Index to these records, compiling and drafting the list of Cabinet meeting subjects (see pp.11 - 37) during her placement at the SRO.

### **The State Records Office of Western Australia (SRO)**

State Cabinet Records are held by the SRO, the authority responsible for identifying, managing, preserving and providing the community with access to the State's Archives. Original records are also available for viewing on request in the Reading Room situated on the third floor of the Alexander Library Building in the Perth Cultural Centre. ## Description of the 1990 State Cabinet Records

The primary set of State Cabinet records referred to in this Guide is called 'Cabinet Minutes and Decisions.' State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions include agendas and submissions to Cabinet and are listed chronologically. They record the meetings of State Cabinet held between 08 January and 17 December 1990 inclusive, and are described on SRO's catalogue as [State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions \(Series 1228, Consignment 4736\)](#).

Other State Cabinet records which complement the Minutes and Decisions, include [Cabinet Meeting Summaries for 1990 \(Series 1230, Consignment 4823, items S08 and S09\)](#), and submissions, reports and other accompanying documents to the Minutes and Decisions, each of which is described as a ["Cabinet Record" \(Series 1228, Consignment 6150\)](#).

### Cabinet Minutes and Decisions

State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions are the primary original source documents that reveal government decisions made at Cabinet meetings. These documents contain the names of the Ministers present and absent at each meeting, supporting reports, copies, summaries or reviews of submissions, and a record of ministerial recommendations, including decisions, approvals, deferrals by State Cabinet.

## World Events that Made the News in 1990<sup>(1)</sup>

February 1990 saw the release of Nelson Mandela after 27 years imprisonment for opposing apartheid in South Africa and President F.W. de Klerk also announced official plans to negotiate the end of apartheid. Additionally, the year was marked by several other significant political changes such as the resignation of Margaret Thatcher as Prime Minister of Great Britain, and the collapse of the communist regimes in Yugoslavia, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (USSR) and several other Baltic States.

Dissolution of communist regimes also occurred in many countries that had formerly been part of the USSR, including Russia itself. The gradual dismantling of Mikhail Gorbachev's economic/political policies, *perestroika* and *glasnost*, generated significant social unrest in the former Soviet Union and contributed to a rise of anti-government sentiment. In turn the former Soviet republics and many other eastern European countries had the task of tentatively implementing new democratic reforms in places where liberal democracy had been a foreign concept for many decades.

In the Middle East tensions between the United States and Iraq flared after Iraq invaded Kuwait on 2 August. After the failure of diplomatic efforts, the US Defense Secretary, Dick Cheney issued Iraq with the warning that failure to promptly leave Kuwait would result in armed conflict between the two countries. This warning was dismissed by Iraqi President, Saddam Hussein, and Iraq continued to occupy Kuwait.

Significant scientific and technology milestones included the creation of the first web server, which laid the foundation for what eventually became the world wide web, and the launch by NASA of the Hubble Space Telescope.

In entertainment, popular Hollywood movie releases in 1990 were *Ghost* and *Home Alone*. 1990 also saw African American actors Denzel Washington win an Oscar for best supporting actor, and Will Smith premier as the lead in the *Fresh Prince of Bel Air*. Madonna's 'Vogue', Sinead O'Connor's 'Nothing Compares 2 U' and MC Hammer's 'U Can't Touch This' became worldwide music hits.

## **Australian Events that Made the News in 1990<sup>(2)</sup>**

The Bob Hawke led Labor Government continued in power in 1990, winning the Federal election on 24 March with a reduced majority. In January recessionary trends in the Australian economy concerned the Federal Government and it was apparent that Australia was in the initial stages of a recession. To reduce economic strain, the Reserve Bank started cutting the 17.5% interest rate so that by December 1990 the interest rate had fallen to 12%.

Of national note, and occurring in WA, on 12 February 1990 Dr Carmen Lawrence became the first female Premier of any State in Australia. In June the notorious serial killer, John Wayne Glover, was captured in Sydney after a bizarre spree of "Granny" murders. Also in June, hundreds of Aboriginal people and allies demonstrated at the New South Wales Parliament House to protest the NSW Government's proposed dissolution of the NSW Aboriginal Land Council. WA entrepreneur Robert Holmes a Court died in September and Nobel Prize winning Australian author Patrick White also died at the end of the same month.

In sport, at the Commonwealth Games hosted by Auckland, New Zealand; Australian athletes won a total of 162 medals, comprising 52 gold, 54 silver and 56 bronze. In 1990 Ivan Lendl and Steffi Graf won Australian Open Tennis Singles Titles and Collingwood won the AFL Grand Final, the AFL changing it's name from VFL at the beginning of the year.

## Events and Issues in WA Politics in 1990<sup>(3)</sup>

For WA 1990 marked an historic change in WA politics, with the appointment of Dr Carmen Lawrence as Premier in February, making her the first female Premier in Australian history. The leader of the Opposition was Barry MacKinnon.

Much of Premier Lawrence's first year was focused on issues that arose under the Dowding government. After much public advocacy, on 19 November 1990, Premier Lawrence called a Royal Commission *"To inquire into and report"* whether there had been *"corruption, illegal conduct, improper conduct, or bribery"* on the part of any person or corporation in the *"affairs, investment decisions and business dealings of the Government of Western Australia or its agencies"*, later referred to as WA Inc.

Another key issue for the Lawrence Cabinet in 1990 was the plans for the old Swan Brewery site. Aboriginal campaigners insisted that the land should be used as an Aboriginal cultural site and parkland, while others wanted the land and buildings to be used as a heritage, tourism and cultural site. By the end of 1990 the matter was still unresolved.

1990 saw a notable increase in Juvenile crime in WA. Several high-speed chases between police and juvenile offenders resulted in the deaths of 10 people and received substantial media coverage. Apple Scab disease endangered WA agricultural industry, with the number of apple scab detections increasing significantly in 1990 after the first two cases were reported in December 1989 in two separate orchards. An Apple Scab eradication and surveillance plan rolled out in WA in 1990.

Curtin University, Murdoch University and the University of Western Australia petitioned the state government for a \$250,000 contribution towards the purchase of a SHRIMP Ion Microprobe. This device was able of analysing and dating geological materials, making it an invaluable asset for WA's mining industry.
