

From Design to Commissioning: Armadale Hub



Considerations for the development of a five-year Service Agreement:

- Service Level Outcomes developed for the first Hubs – same across program
- Lots of other expectations/requirements!
- Curtin Evaluation on first two Hubs timing of report
- 'Joining up' SMEs, Procurement, Legal
- Lead Service Provider & subcontracting arrangements
- ACCO vs mainstream

Hubs Program - Service Level Outcomes

- 1. Safety of people experiencing FDV in WA is increased.
- 2. The trauma from re-telling of experiences of FDV is reduced.
- 3. People experiencing FDV in WA with children are able to meet their children's needs.
- 4. People experiencing FDV in WA are supported and have their needs met.
- 5. People receive personalised care and trust the service they received.
- 6. Perpetrators of FDV in WA are visible.
- 7. Local services have increased capacity to respond to FDV.

Curtin Evaluation of Hubs (1&2) 2022:

Recommendation 7: SLOs should be reviewed to develop stronger a conceptual focus and have more logical organisation, which is underpinned by an evidence-based program logic model.

"It would be timely to review the SLOs considering the emerging evidence and experience within Hubs. However, what the mapping to SLOs shows is that the evaluation has reported on many positive aspects about the Hubs and what they have been able to achieve with client services."
