#### Introduction to Metropolitan Region Scheme minor amendments

The Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) is responsible for keeping the Metropolitan Region Scheme under review and initiating changes where they are seen as necessary.

The Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) sets out the broad pattern of land use for the whole Perth metropolitan region. The MRS is constantly under review to best reflect regional planning and development needs.

An amendment proposal to change land use reservations and zones in the MRS is regulated by the *Planning and Development Act 2005*. That legislation provides for public submissions to be made on proposed amendments.

For a non-substantial amendment, often referred to as a minor amendment (made under section 57 of the Act), the WAPC considers all the submissions lodged, and publishes its recommendations in a report on submissions. This report is presented to the Minister for Planning for approval. The amendment takes legal effect with Gazettal of the Minister's approval.

In the process of making a non-substantial amendment to the MRS, information is published as a public record under the following titles:

#### Amendment report

This document is available from the start of the public advertising period of the proposed amendment. It sets out the purpose and scope of the proposal, explains why the amendment is considered necessary, and informs people how they can comment through the submission process.

#### **Environmental review report**

The Environmental Protection Authority must consider the environmental impact of an amendment to the MRS before it can be advertised. While formal assessment would be unlikely for a non-substantial amendment, were it required then an environmental review would be undertaken and made available for information and comment at the same time as the amendment report.

#### Report on submissions

The planning rationale, determination of submissions and the WAPC's recommendations for final approval of the amendment, with or without modification, is documented in this report.

#### 1 Introduction

At its 8 December 2021 meeting, the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC), resolved to proceed with this minor amendment to the Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) in accordance with the provisions of Section 57 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*.

The amendment was initiated as a minor amendment to the MRS as the proposal was considered as being relatively minor in nature (as discussed in the previously published *Amendment Report*). The principal differences between minor and major MRS Amendment processes are that the former includes a 60-day advertising period while the period for the latter is three months. The former is not required to be placed before Parliament (for 12 sitting days) while the latter is, and there is no requirement for Submitters to be offered hearings for minor Amendments.

This report summarises the background to minor MRS Amendment 1393/57 and examines the various submissions made on it.

#### 2 The proposed amendment

The amendment proposal was described in the previously published *Amendment Report*, and a description of the proposal is repeated below.

The purpose of the MRS amendment is to reclassify land to the Primary Regional Roads (PRR) reservation, Railways reservation and Industrial zone in the City of Cockburn, between Tapper Road and Midgegooroo Avenue. The proposed amendment reflects the decisions made between State and Local government in 2015, protects the constructed Armadale Road to North Lake Road Bridge PRR reserve in the MRS and allows orderly land use planning to occur.

## 3 Environmental Protection Authority and Department of Water and Environmental Regulation advice

The Environmental Protection Authority considered that the proposed Scheme should not be assessed under Part IV Division 3 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* and that it is not necessary to provide any advice or recommendations.

The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation advised that it had no objection to the proposed amendment.

#### 4 Call for submissions

The amendment was advertised for public submissions for a period of 60 days from Friday 18 March 2022 to Friday 20 May 2022.

The amendment was made available for public inspection during ordinary business hours at the:

- i) Western Australian Planning Commission, 140 William Street, Perth
- ii) City of Cockburn
- iii) State Reference Library, Northbridge.

During the public inspection period, notice of the amendment was published in *The West Australian* and relevant local newspapers circulating in the locality of the amendment.

#### 5 Submissions

Nine submissions were received on the amendment. An index of all the persons and organisations lodging submissions is at Schedule 1.

- Eight submissions contained general comment/non-objection on the amendment.
- One submission supportive of the proposed amendment with comments.

A summary of each submission with WAPC comments and determinations is at Schedule 2. A complete copy of all written submissions is contained in this report.

#### 6 Modifications

No modifications are proposed.

#### 7 Responses and determinations

The responses to all submissions are detailed in Schedule 2 - Summary of Submissions and determinations. It is recommended that the amendment be adopted for finalisation without modification.

#### 8 Coordination of region and local scheme amendments

Under section 126(1) of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* if a region planning scheme delineates land comprised in a local planning scheme for any public purpose, then the local planning scheme, in so far as it operated in relation to that land is, by force of this Section, and without any further action under this Act, amended to such extent (if any) as is necessary to give effect to the reservation under the region planning scheme.

Under section 126(3) of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* the WAPC has the option of concurrently rezoning land that is being zoned Urban under the MRS, to a "Development" zone (or similar) in the Local Planning Scheme. However, as no land is being zoned Urban by the amendment, Section 126(3) is not applicable to the amendment.

The City of Cockburn will need to amend its local planning scheme to reclassify the land which is be transferred to the Industrial zone in the MRS to a suitable classification under Local Planning Scheme 3 (LPS 3). This land could potentially be reclassified as a Local Road reserve under LPS 3 or transferred to the Development zone and Development Area 20, pursuant to the requirements of section 124(2) of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*.

#### 9 Conclusion and recommendation

This report summarises the background to minor MRS Amendment 1393/57 and examines the various submissions made on it.

The WAPC, after considering the submissions, is satisfied that the amendment as shown generally on the Amendment Figure – Proposal 1 in Schedule 3, and in detail on the MRS amendment plan listed in Appendix 1 should be approved and finalised.

Having regard to the above, the WAPC recommends that the Minister for Planning approves the amendment.

#### 10 Ministers decision

Amendments to the MRS using the provisions of section 57 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* require the WAPC to provide a report and recommendation to the Minister for Planning for approval. The Minister may approve, approve with modification or decline to approve the proposed amendment.

The Minister considered the WAPC's recommendation and resolved that the amendment be approved as modified by removing the proposed rezoning of part of Lot 28 (33) Cutler Road, Jandakot from Other Regional Roads (ORR) reservation to an Industrial zone. The subject land was recently rezoned from ORR reservation to Industrial, as part of the MRS Amendment 1380/57 – South-East and South-West Districts Omnibus 4, dated 8 December 2022; hence a rezoning duplication in 1393/57.

MRS Amendment 1393/57 is now finalised as modified by the Minister and shown on WAPC Amending Plan 3.2786 (version 4) and has effect in the MRS from the date of notice in the Government Gazette on 21 April 2023.

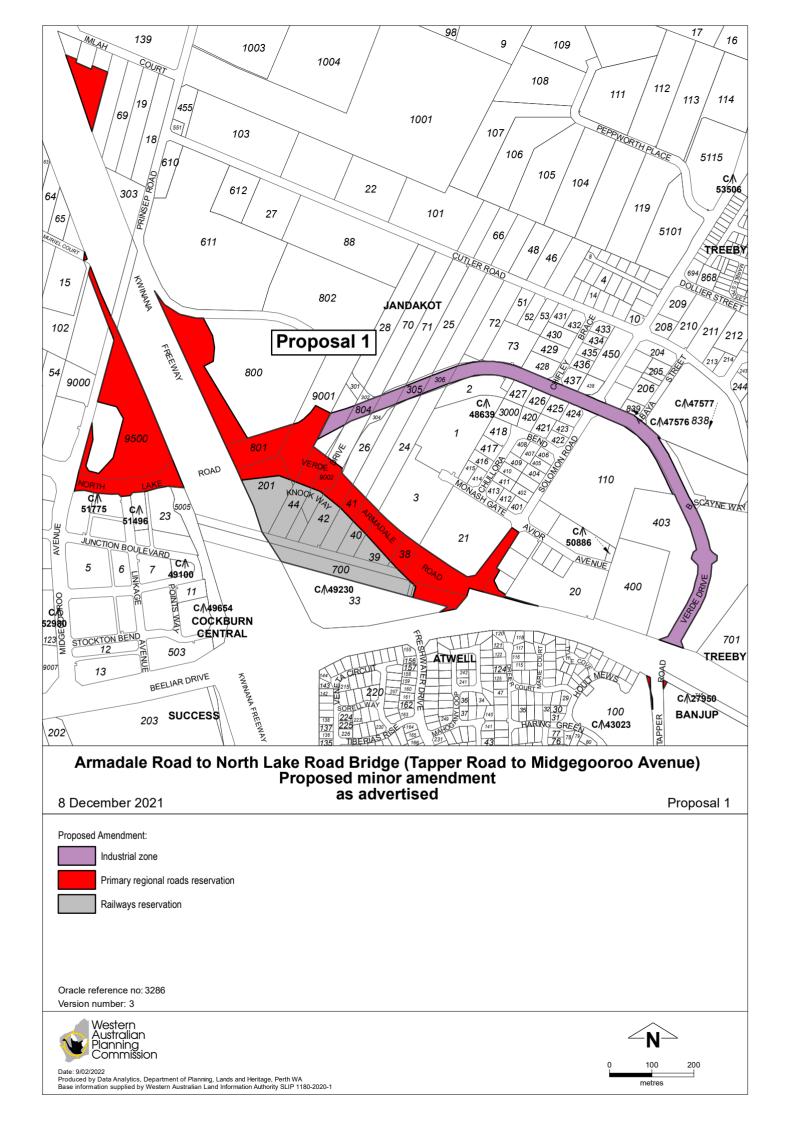



ATCO has Critical Infrastructure in the proposed amendment areas 'PRR' and 'Railways reservation,' please see attached DBYD – LM22223 – PRR and Railway Reservation.

ATCO owns and operates a Critical DN300 ST HP 1900kPa pipeline as seen in LM22223 – PRR and Railway Reservation.

ATCO require confirmation that access rights for pipeline patrol in these areas will not be impeded and impacted by the proposed MRS amendment. In particular, ATCO require confirmation that access to the ATCO asset within the rail corridor will not be impeded and impacted as a result of the proposed MRS amendment.

ATCO also owns and operates a DN110 PE MP 70kPa pipeline on the intersection of Verde Road and Armadale Road. This ATCO pipeline appears to encroach within the proposed parcel of land that will be reclassified as Industrial Zone if this amendment is approved. ATCO requires confirmation that as a result of the proposed amendment this ATCO asset would still be installed within road reserve. If this is not the case this pipeline will need to be relocated at the proponents expense. Please see attached DBYD – LM22223 – Verde Road for reference.





It is noted that our concerns raised at the preliminary review and relating to Verde Drive have now been resolved. The City would like to thank the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage and Main Roads WA for their continued engagement on this matter.
