NOTICE OF AREAS CLOSED TO FISHING FOR PRAWNS IN THE BROOME PRAWN MANAGED FISHERY FOR 2023, 2024 AND 2025

Notice No. 1 of 2023

I, Rick Fletcher, Executive Director, Fisheries and Agriculture Resource Management of the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development, in accordance with clause 12 of the *Broome Prawn Managed Fishery Management Plan 1999* (the Plan), being of the opinion that the prohibition is required in the better interests of the Broome Prawn Managed Fishery, do hereby -

- 1. cancel Notice of Areas Closed to Fishing for Prawns: *Notice No.1 of 2020*, dated 6 May 2020; and
- 2. prohibit fishing for prawns in those parts of the Broome Prawn Managed Fishery (the Fishery), as described in Schedule 2 of the Plan, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 1700 hours Western Standard Time (WST) on 15 May 2023; from 0800 hours WST on 8 October 2023 until 1700 hours WST on 15 May 2024; from 0800 hours WST on 8 October 2024 until 1700 hours WST on 15 May 2025; and from 0800 hours WST on 8 October 2025 until 1700 hours WST on 15 May 2026.
