1. This ban should extend to all plastic carry bags including those greater than 35 microns and include those without handles.
2. The WA government should also ban plastic microbeads in cosmetics.
3. The WA government should also ban plastic straws, single use coffee cups and balloons.
3. The WA government should provide a broad community education campaign on the need to reduce plastic consumption, recycle correctly and discourage all single use disposable products and materials.
4. The WA Government should provide incentives and support for industry to provide non plastic carry bags and reduce plastic packaging.
5. The WA Government should provide public place recycling bins to increase collection of recyclables and reduce residual waste.
6. The Government should provide public place water refill stations at all major public exercise ovals, beaches and public parks to curb single use disposable plastic beverage containers.
6. The WA Government needs to reframe this ban to be about reducing plastic...not just reducing litter.
