We appreciate the opportunity to provide feedback on the Draft Rule Change Report: Various Pilbara ISO Functions (PRC_2023_01)

Alinta Energy broadly supports the additional amendments to the proposed amending rules, subject to consideration of the below issues:

Clause	Summary	Comment and recommendation
274P	Proposed clause 274P states that costs incurred under subchapter 9.2 or subchapter 9.3 for a Covered NSP are to be dealt with in accordance with its User Access Guide under the PNAC.	Alinta Energy notes that section 42(2) of the PNAC only requires a User Access to set out the basis for determining how reasonable costs to be paid by the applicant in respect of preliminary enquiries and further investigations. An NSP may incur other costs in performing its functions under subchapter 9.2 or subchapter 9.3 and these costs would likely be agreed commercially. Alinta Considers that this clause should be amended as follows: An NSP's costs of performing a function under Subchapter 9.2 or Subchapter 9.3, including the payment of any fee under rule 274Q 2— (a) for a Covered NSP — are to be dealt with in accordance with its User Access Guide under the PNAC or as otherwise agreed between the parties;
274R	Proposed clause 274R states that the Connection Applicant is to bear its own, and the Registered NSP's, costs of implementing, operating and maintaining costs associated with a connection (referencing the User Access Guide)	Similar to the above, Alinta Energy notes that a Connection Applicant and an NSP may come to a separate commercial agreement as to how costs are to be allocated. Alinta Considers that this clause should be amended as follows: Subject to rule 274R(2), and the User Access Guide under the PNAC, or as otherwise agreed between the parties, the Connection Applicant is to bear its

		own, and the Registered NSP's, costs of implementing, operating and maintaining — (a) any solution under rule 270(5) or otherwise required to achieve connection under Subchapter 9.2; and (b) the CPC Measures for a CPC Facility.
