Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy Regulations 2008

Regulation 5 of the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy Regulations 2008 sets out the circumstances under which licensees can apply to claim an exemption from the regulations.

Licensees are required to use this form to apply for an exemption under **regulation 5(1)(g)** being:

Waste used for construction or maintenance work carried out on the licensed landfill if:

- (i) the amount of waste is specified in advance in a plan prepared by a registered builder or an engineer; and
- (ii) no charge is made by the licensee for accepting the waste.

Instructions

Before submitting this application form please ensure that you have completed all required fields, signed the form and have included copies of required supporting information as set out in the form.

If there is insufficient space on any part of this form, please continue on a separate page and attach to this application form, ensuring that all pages are numbered.

Incomplete or illegible applications will not be assessed. If you require assistance in completing any part of this application form, please contact the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) on (08) 6364 6963. DWER recommends that a copy of this form is retained by the licensee.

Please note that exemptions must be granted prior to 28 days after the end of a return period to avoid levy liability arising. Exemptions granted after this time will result in the payment of a refund on the amount of levy paid by the licensee.

The licensee must submit with the exemption application plans prepared by a registered builder or engineer which:

- illustrate in (a) drawing(s) the construction or maintenance work to be completed, including cross-sections
- stipulate the amount of waste in cubic metres or tonnes, which will be used to complete the work;
- demonstrate how the required volume of waste was calculated
- detail what waste materials are proposed to be used
- show where on the site the works are to be carried out.

In addition to the plans, copies of the registered builder's or engineer's qualifications must also be supplied to DWER.

The exemption application should generally be submitted prior to commencing the works subject to the application, however applications can also be made after works have commenced.

Evidence that the licensee did not or will not charge to accept the waste at the landfill.
