



Factsheet CAT07 Categories of child-related work 7: the performance by an officer



The performance by an officer, as defined in the *Children and Community Services Act 2004*, of a function given to the officer under that Act.

Roles considered to be in child-related work

Some examples of roles considered to be in <u>child-related work</u> are listed below. Please note that in all cases, for a role to be considered to be in child-related work, the **usual duties** of that role must involve, or be likely to involve, **contact** with a **child**. Roles include:

- Department of Communities
 - o officers
 - contract workers
 - volunteers
 - students

providing protection and support services to children and families.

Exemptions

The following <u>exemptions</u> apply to this category:

- child volunteers under 18 years of age
- unpaid students on placement under 18 years of age
- short-term visitors to WA.
