DETERMINATION VARIATION

PREAMBLE

The Salaries and Allowances Tribunal has issued a determination to clarify the costs of expenses incurred when a former Premier requires the use of a carer to provide physical or medical assistance while travelling to an official function.

DETERMINATION

The determination of the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal made 27 February 2017 under section 6B of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below, with effect on and from 31 July 2023.

Delete Part 3.4, and insert the following:

3.4 Travel

- 1. A Former Premier who is invited to attend an official function:
 - a. Within Australia, is entitled to claim reimbursement of travelling and accommodation costs; and
 - b. held overseas, must apply to the Tribunal to determine whether associated costs of travelling and accommodation shall be met by the Government.
- 2. Where a Former Premier requires a carer to accompany them on travel to provide physical or medical assistance, the carer's travelling and accommodation costs can be covered on the same basis as Part 3.4(1).
