## Introduction

Each year the State Records Office of WA (SRO) publishes an online Guide to State Cabinet records which have been released from their 30-year restriction access period in the previous calendar year. This year's Guide reviews the 1992 State Cabinet minutes and decisions 1992 and also includes the first Cabinet meeting of 1993.

State Cabinet records are historically significant documents which reveal the decisions made by the government of the day. These unique records are the primary source documents for information about the issues raised at Cabinet meetings. This online Guide is intended to assist the Western Australian community with access to these records. The Guide also provides an overview of Western Australian state issues in 1992, as well as highlighting a few prominent national and international news events of that year for context. A list of the topics and subjects discussed at each meeting of State Cabinet in 1992 is provided in this Guide to assist with further research into the records. This list includes a link to the SRO's online catalogue to enable the public to view relevant State Cabinet records online.

Unlike the release of Cabinet papers at the Commonwealth level, where records comprising more sensitive information can be embargoed beyond the restriction access period for the remaining records, all State Cabinet records for Western Australia are generally released for public access 30 years after the records are created.

This year (2023) the Guide to the 1992 State Cabinet Records has been produced with the assistance of Ms Mehardeep Kaur, a student from the University of Western Australia during a McCusker Centre for Citizenship Internship at the SRO. During her placement she researched the 1992 State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions and Meeting Summaries, compiling a detailed list of Cabinet meeting subjects (see pp.12 - 36), as well as drafting sections on world, national and local events.

## How to access State Cabinet papers in the State archive collection

State Cabinet Records are held by the SRO, the entity responsible for identifying, managing, preserving, and providing access to the State's Archives. The State Cabinet Records listed in this Guide can be accessed online via the SRO's catalogue at: <https://archive.sro.wa.gov.au>.

Original records are also available for viewing on request in the Reading Room on the third floor of the Alexander Library Building in the Perth Cultural Centre. Records must be requested in advance via the SRO's catalogue. The Reading Room is open during library opening hours. Research support appointments can also be booked online via the SRO's website. ## Description of the 1992 State Cabinet Records

The primary set of State Cabinet records referred to in this Guide is called 'Cabinet Minutes and Decisions.' State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions include agendas and submissions to Cabinet and are listed chronologically. They record the meetings of State Cabinet held between 06 January 1992 and 05 January 1993 inclusive, and are described on SRO's catalogue as [State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions \(Series 1228, Consignment 4736\)](#).

Other State Cabinet records which complement the Minutes and Decisions, include [Cabinet Meeting Summaries for 1992 \(Series 1230, Consignment 4823, items S11\)](#), and submissions, reports and other accompanying documents to the Minutes and Decisions, each of which is described as a "[Cabinet Record](#)" ([Series 1228, Consignment 6150](#)).

### Cabinet Minutes and Decisions

State Cabinet Minutes and Decisions are the primary original source documents that describe decisions made at Cabinet meetings. These documents contain the names of the Ministers present and absent at each meeting, supporting reports, copies, summaries or reviews of submissions, and a record of ministerial recommendations, including decisions, approvals, deferrals by State Cabinet.

## World Events that Made the News in 1992<sup>(1)</sup>

1992 was a significant year in terms of global events that had a profound impact on the world. The U.S. President Bush and the Russian President Yeltsin jointly announced that the end of the Cold War, which also saw the dissolution of the Soviet Union which had been a superpower for several decades. It was also the year of the signing of the Maastricht Treaty, which led to the formation of the European Union. This treaty also established a single currency, the euro, which paved the way for closer political and economic integration among many member states. These two events had far-reaching consequences permanently altering the international politics.

Environmental issues also captured public attention in 1992. The United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED), also known as the Earth Summit, was held in Rio De Janeiro, Brazil in June. Australia's delegation, led by Prime Minister Paul Keating, advocated for greater international cooperation to address environmental challenges.

Various developments occurred in the world of technology in 1992. In December the first ever text message was transmitted when engineer Neil Papworth typed "Merry Christmas" on a computer and sent it to the Vodafone director Richard Jarvis' mobile phone. Also, the popular file type JPEG, an acronym for "Joint Photographic Experts Group" was introduced as a standard for digital images in 1992.

In popular culture, the movie "Aladdin" became a worldwide success and critically acclaimed American filmmaker Quentin Tarantino debuted with the release of "Reservoir Dogs" which is often regarded as a classic independent and cult film. "Achy Breaky Heart" by Billy Ray Cyrus spent 7 weeks at number 1 in the Australian singles chart in 1992 and the popular video game "Mortal Kombat" was released, sparking debates about the portrayal of violence in video games.

In sport 1992 was the year of the Barcelona Olympics where Australia won 7 gold, 9 silver and 11 bronze medals. The Gold winning United States basketball team at Barcelona, nicknamed 'the Dream Team', has been described by some sports journalists as the greatest sports team ever assembled.

## Australian Events that Made the News in 1992<sup>(2)</sup>

In 1992 Australia experienced several landmark events that shaped the socio-political space. The Mabo ruling, handed down by the High Court in June 1992, recognized the existence of native title, replacing and overturning the notion of *terra nullius*. On 10 December, Prime Minister Keating delivered a historic speech in Redfern Park, launching Australia's program for the International Year of the World's Indigenous People.

Australia played a key role in the United Nations peacekeeping mission in Cambodia in 1992, contributing troops and resources to the mission, aiming to bring stability to the war-torn country following years of conflict. This mission enabled a new era of peace in Cambodia.

The economy was a topic of concern in 1992 as Australia was going through the aftermath of a recession leading to unemployment and other economic problems. This led to a range of policy reforms aimed at reducing inflation and stimulating growth.

In 1992, Australia also experienced its share of natural disasters which included severe droughts leading to a loss of crops and livestock, affecting farmers and rural communities across the nation. In addition to that, a series of bushfires in the states of New South Wales and Victoria destroyed homes and claimed several lives.

1992 was a year of firsts and lasts in the world of Pop culture. The first 'Big Day Out' music festival was held at the Sydney Showgrounds, headlined by Violent Femmes and Nirvana. Shortly after, the first WOMADelaide festival was also held at Botanic Park as part of the Adelaide Festival of Arts. The ABC debuted the children's TV series 'Bananas in Pyjamas', but popular TV shows like 'Fast Forward', 'Acropolis Now' and 'The Big Gig' came to an end during the year.

The Cricket World Cup 1992 was jointly hosted by Australia and New Zealand, being the first to feature coloured jerseys, white cricket balls and black sight screens, with several matches being played under floodlights. The final was played between England and Pakistan, and Pakistan emerged victorious. The AFL premiership was won by the West Coast Eagles, defeating Geelong by 28 points.

## Events and Issues in WA Politics in 1992<sup>(3)</sup>

In 1992 the Premier of Western Australia was Dr. Carmen Lawrence, Australia's first female State Premier and a member of the Australian Labor Party.

The Royal Commission into Commercial Activities of Government (WA Inc) continued its investigation into allegations of corruption. The Commission found that some members of the Government had engaged in illegal activities to enrich themselves and their associates.

The release of the Royal Commission into Aboriginal Deaths in Custody's final report in July led to calls for reform of the justice system. In response, Cabinet increased funding for programs aimed at improving Indigenous health, education, and employment.

On the economic forefront, Western Australia was struggling due to a downturn in the mining industry. Some were critical of the State for its handling of the economic situation, arguing that it had not done enough to diversify the state's economy and reduce its reliance on mining.

Other issues discussed at State Cabinet meetings included the need to improve road infrastructure in the state, increases in pay-roll tax thresholds and land tax relief measures, and the provision of more public housing. The government also introduced a range of new legislation, including amendments to the Mining Act, and a proposal to establish an Environmental Appeals Committee.

Overall, 1992 was a challenging year for the government of Western Australia, with significant political, economic, and social events dominating the state's agenda. At the same time State Cabinet aimed to make progress towards a more just and equitable society.
