These projects could see Western Australia produce over 100 gigawatts of renewable energy for hydrogen by 2030, which could increase to 200 gigawatts by 2040.

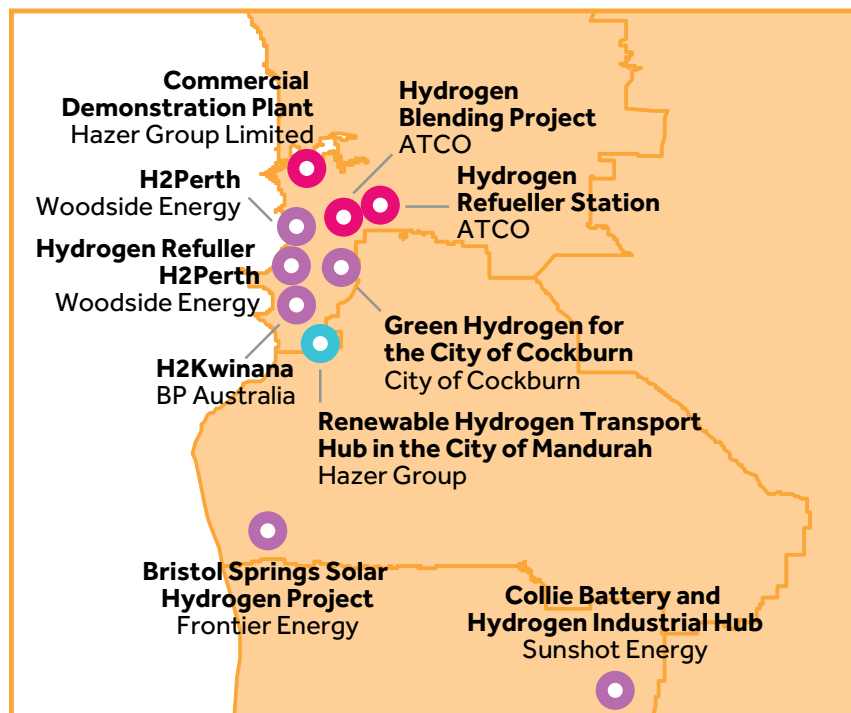

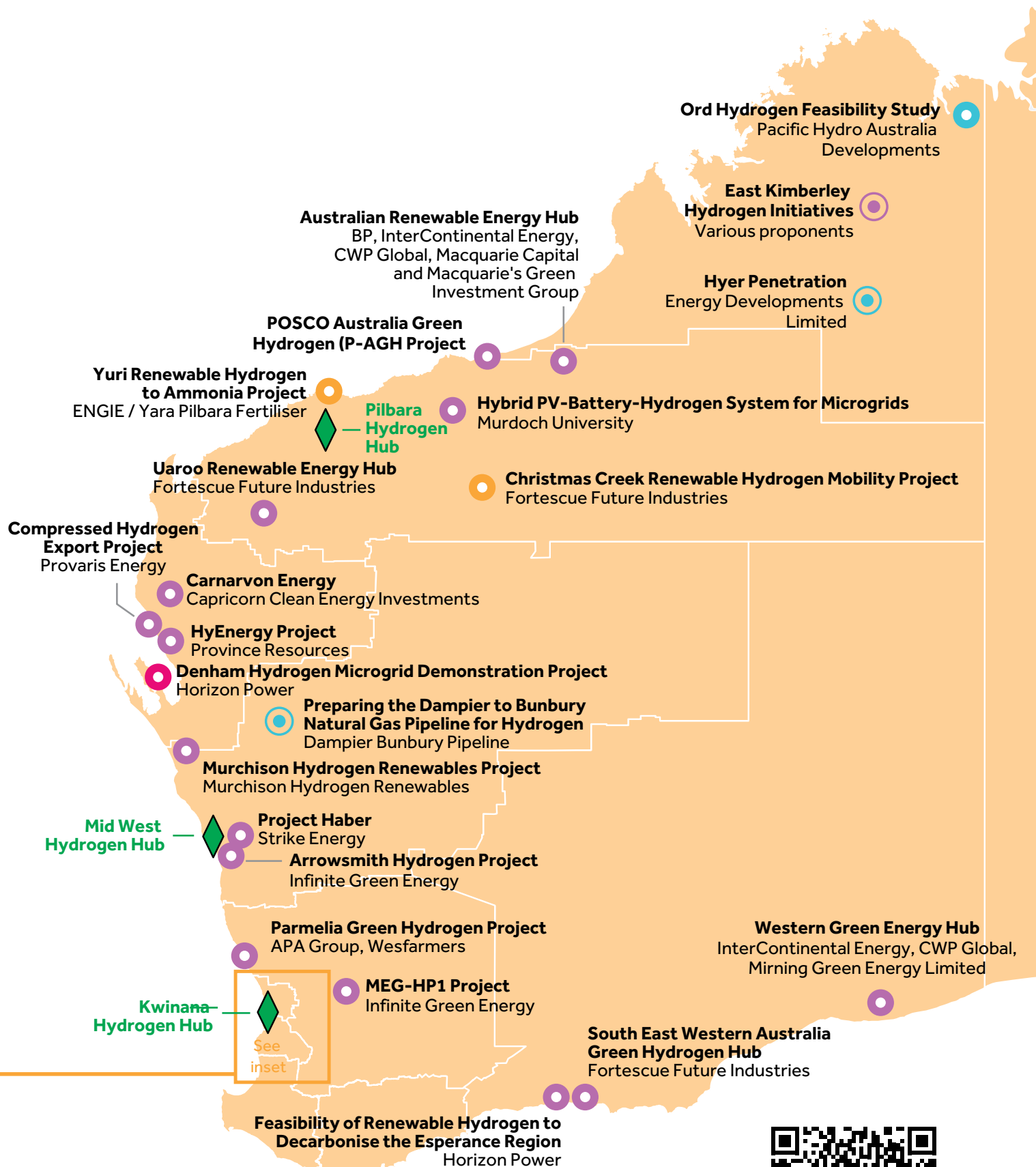
