Introduction to Metropolitan Region Scheme minor amendments

The Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) is responsible for keeping the Metropolitan Region Scheme under review and initiating changes where they are seen as necessary.

The Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) sets out the broad pattern of land use for the whole Perth metropolitan region. The MRS is constantly under review to best reflect regional planning and development needs.

An amendment proposal to change land use reservations and zones in the MRS is regulated by the *Planning and Development Act 2005*. That legislation provides for public submissions to be made on proposed amendments.

For a non-substantial amendment, often referred to as a minor amendment (made under former section 57 of the Act), the WAPC considers all the submissions lodged, and publishes its recommendations in a report on submissions. This report is presented to the Minister for Planning for approval. The amendment takes legal effect with Gazettal of the Minister's approval.

In the process of making a non-substantial amendment to the MRS, information is published as a public record under the following titles:

Amendment report

This document is available from the start of the public advertising period of the proposed amendment. It sets out the purpose and scope of the proposal, explains why the amendment is considered necessary, and informs people how they can comment through the submission process.

Environmental review report

The Environmental Protection Authority must consider the environmental impact of an amendment to the MRS before it can be advertised. While formal assessment would be unlikely for a non-substantial amendment, were it required then an environmental review would be undertaken and made available for information and comment at the same time as the amendment report.

Report on submissions

The planning rationale, determination of submissions and the WAPC's recommendations for final approval of the amendment, with or without modification, is documented in this report.

1 Introduction

At its February 2023 meeting, the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) resolved to proceed with this amendment to the Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) in accordance with the provisions of former Section 57 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*.

The principal differences between the minor and the major MRS amendment processes are that the former includes a 60-day advertising period while the period for the latter is 90 days, the former is not required to placed before Parliament (for 12 sitting days) while the latter is and there is no requirement for submitters to be offered hearings for minor amendments.

2 The proposed amendment

Purpose

The amendment proposal was described in the previously published *Amendment Report*, and a description of the proposal is repeated below.

The purpose of the amendment is to rezone approximately 4.36 ha in Beaconsfield from the Public Purposes - Technical School reserve to the Urban zone under the MRS as shown on the *Amendment Figure – Proposal 1*.

The amendment is proposed to enable the redevelopment of the former Challenger TAFE site for residential purposes, following the closure of the TAFE site and distribution of its functions to other metropolitan campuses in 2017. Demolition of all structures on the site commenced in 2022 and the site is largely cleared with the exception of retained trees in the South-East and South-West corners of the site.

3 Environmental Protection Authority advice

On 5 April 2023, the Environmental Protection Authority considered that the proposed amendment should not be assessed under Part IV Division 3 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986 and* provided advice on flora and vegetation. A copy of the notice from the EPA is in Appendix A of the *Amendment Report*.

4 Call for submissions

The amendment was advertised for public submissions from 9 June 2023 to 9 August 2023. The amendment was made available for public inspection during ordinary business hours at:

- i) Western Australian Planning Commission, 140 William Street, Perth
- ii) City of Fremantle
- iii) the State Reference Library, Northbridge.

During the public inspection period, notice of the amendment was published in *The West Australian* and relevant local newspaper/s circulating in the locality of the amendment.

5 Submissions

Eleven submissions were received on the amendment. An alphabetic index of all the persons and organisations lodging submissions is at Schedule 1.

One submission was of support and 10 submissions were of general comment, non-objection or no comment. There were no objecting submissions or matters raised which required further consideration.

A summary of each submission with WAPC comments and determinations is at Schedule 2. A complete copy of all written submissions is contained in this report.

6 Determinations

The responses to all submissions are detailed in Schedule 2 *Summary of submissions and determinations*. It is recommended that the amendment be adopted for finalisation as advertised.

7 Co-ordination of region and local scheme amendments

Under section 126(3) of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* the WAPC has the option of concurrently rezoning land that is being zoned Urban under the MRS, to a "Development" zone (or similar) in the corresponding LPS. The WAPC has supported the concurrent LPS amendment of the site to the "Development" zone in the City of Fremantle Local Planning Scheme No. 4.

8 Conclusion and recommendation

This report summarises the background to minor amendment 1401/57 and examines the various submissions made on it. The WAPC, after considering the submissions, is satisfied that the amendment as shown generally on the Amendment Figure - Proposal 1 in Schedule 3 and in detail on the MRS amendment Plan listed in Appendix 1 should be approved and finalised.

The WAPC recommends that the Minister for Planning approves the amendment.

9 Ministers decision

Amendments to the Metropolitan Region Scheme using the provisions of former section 57 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* require the WAPC to provide a report and recommendation to the Minister for Planning for approval. The Minister may approve, approve with modification or decline to approve the proposed amendment.

The Minister, after considering the amendment, has agreed with the recommendation of the WAPC and approved the amendment.

MRS Amendment 1401/57 is now finalised as advertised and shown on WAPC Amending Plan 3.2802, and has effect in the Metropolitan Region Scheme from the date of notice in the *Government Gazette* on 10 November 2023.





- Given the location of the subject site in relation to the South Street 'Urban Corridor', Fremantle Activity Centre, and with Fremantle College located across Lefroy Rd, the provision of accessible, legible and safe pedestrian and cycling connections should be planned for future development of the subject site.



The Water Corporation has no objection to the proposed rezoning. The subject land site is located within an established network of water and sewerage and the future redevelopment of this site can be serviced by extension off the network. The proponent may be required to undertake some upgrades to the network to support the servicing of the land, depending on the final land uses and development yield.

As part of the Corporation's long-term wastewater planning for this part of the metropolitan area, the Corporation has planned to construct a wastewater diversion pressure main from the Sampson Street WWPS to the north, through the western edge of this land heading south to another part of the Fremantle Sewer District. The pressure main is planned to be located along the western edge of the site generally as depicted on the attached plan. The pressure main is scheduled to be required around 2040 onwards. The Commission is requested to provide this information to the proponents to ensure the matter is addressed in the future local structure plan over the site.

SUMMARY

The Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage (DPLH) has commenced public engagement on a proposed Minor Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) Amendment for the former Beaconsfield TAFE site. The amendment proposes to rezone Lot 2680, 11 – 15 Grosvenor Street, Beaconsfield, as well as an adjacent portion of Lefroy Road from the 'Public Purposes – Technical School' reserve to the 'Urban' zone.

Should the amendment be approved, the future use and development of the site would be subject to the requirements of the City of Fremantle Local Planning Scheme No. 4 (LPS 4). Section 126(3) of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* allows for, where land is amended to Urban under the MRS, the local planning scheme to be automatically amended to the 'Development' zone. This allows for a structure plan to be considered over the site as a separate process.

This report recommends that Council:

Lodge a submission with the DPLH on the proposed Minor MRS Amendment for the former Beaconsfield TAFE site:

- Expressing support for the land included to be designated as 'Urban' in the MRS
- b. Expressing support for the MRS amendment process to, once approved, concurrently zone the land to the 'Development' zone under LPS4.



BACKGROUND

The Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage (DPLH) has commenced public engagement on a proposed Minor Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) Amendment for the former Beaconsfield TAFE site. The amendment proposes to rezone Lot 2680, 11 – 15 Grosvenor Street, Beaconsfield as well as an adjacent portion of Lefroy Road from the 'Public Purposes – Technical School' reserve to the 'Urban' zone.

The proposed amendment will enable the redevelopment of the former Challenger TAFE site for residential purposes, following the closure of the TAFE and distribution of its functions to other metropolitan campuses in 2017.

The WAPC certifies that, in its opinion, the proposed amendment does not constitute a substantial alteration to the MRS. Accordingly, the amendment is considered a minor amendment.

Amendment area

The amendment area is located approximately 15 kilometres south-west of the Perth central business district and 2.25 kilometres south-east of Fremantle city centre. The site is owned by the state government and was previously the grounds of the Challenger TAFE, which closed in 2017. In 2022 the buildings on site were demolished and the site cleared, except for a number of mature trees, which were retained in the western and south-east extents of the site.

The subject site has an area of approximately 4.36 hectares and is reserved for 'Public Purposes – Technical School' under the MRS, lying adjacent to 'Urban' zoned land to the west, north and east. An MRS reservation for 'Public Purposes – High School' is located directly south of the subject site, over the site of Fremantle College.

Concurrent Local Scheme Amendment

Under Section 126(3) of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*, where a region scheme is amended to include land in the 'Urban' zone, the local planning scheme may be automatically amended, following consultation with local government and by a notice published by the Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC).



The WAPC has identified, as part of initiating this MRS amendment, a concurrent scheme amendment to the City's LPS 4 to the 'Development' zone. A determination on whether the concurrent local planning scheme amendment is finalised will be made following advertising of the MRS amendment, including consideration of submissions and advice from the local government and the Environmental Protection Authority.

The local planning scheme is updated by publication of a notice in the Government Gazette. The 'Development' zone is defined as follows:

"The purpose of the Development Zone is to provide for future residential, industrial, commercial or other uses in accordance with a comprehensive structure plan or Local Development Plan prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Scheme."

CONSULTATION

Community Engagement on the MRS amendment closes 9 August 2023. Once submissions have been received by the WAPC, the WAPC will consider the submissions and present the amendment to the Minister for Planning, with or without modifications. The Minister will then determine whether the amendment should proceed, be withdrawn or readvertised due to modification.

OFFICER COMMENT

The closure of Challenger TAFE and its subsequent demolition has rendered the existing 'Public Purposes – Technical School' reserve permanently redundant. There is no longer a need for the reservation to be retained and rezoning to 'Urban' would allow for a structure plan to be considered over the site that meets state planning and local housing diversity aspirations.



The City of Fremantle's Heart of Beaconsfield Concept Masterplan (the Masterplan) demonstrates how the site could be developed for residential use, open space and limited commercial purposes. The Masterplan contemplates the redevelopment of the former Beaconsfield TAFE site for a range of low and medium density developments, including a north-south open space pedestrian link and a commercial node on Lefroy Road, adjacent to Fremantle College.

Notwithstanding the proposed MRS 'Urban' zone and the development contemplated under the Masterplan, future planning for the site, including local zoning, reservations and Residential Design Code density designations, will need to be provided under the LPS4. While this could be done as a separate local planning scheme amendment, a more resource-efficient and streamlined approach would be for a concurrent amendment to LPS4 to the 'Development' zone, which would allow for a local structure plan to be considered over the site.

Accordingly, the MRS amendment to rezone the site from the 'Public Purposes – Technical School' reserve to the 'Urban' zone is supported. The City would also welcome a concurrent local planning scheme amendment to zone the site 'Development' under LPS4.
