# Publishing a Public Sector Notice

### Commissioner's Instruction 5

#### Statement of intent

A clear understanding of what constitutes a public sector notice under the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* (PSM Act).

## Scope and application

This instruction applies to any public sector body publishing a public sector notice under the PSM Act.

#### Instruction

- 1. A <u>Public Sector Notice</u> published by the Public Sector Commission on WA.gov.au is a public sector notice for the purposes of section 40 of the PSM Act [serving a notice where the address of a public service officer is unknown].
- 2. A <u>Public Sector Notice</u> published by the Public Sector Commission on WA.gov.au is a public sector notice for the purposes of sections 43(3) and 43(4) of the PSM Act [making a declaration of an inclusion or exclusion from the Senior Executive Service].
- 3. An advertisement on the WA Government's jobs board, <u>Jobs WA</u>, is a public sector notice for the purposes of section 64(4) of the PSM Act [advertising a vacancy for permanent employment].
- 4. Notification on the <u>Public Sector Commission website</u> is a public sector notice for the purpose of clause 5 of Schedule 5 of the PSM Act [repealing an administrative instruction].
