Meeting 6, 23 November 2023

Latest news

The sixth meeting of the Exmouth Gulf Taskforce (the Taskforce) was held in Perth on 23 November 2023. The meeting was chaired by Ms Michelle Andrews, Director General, Department of Water and Environmental Regulation.

The Taskforce discussed a range of topics, including:

- Water Corporation: Exmouth Water Supply
- Dr Bill Humphreys: Cape Range Subterranean Fauna
- Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER): Salt Farms and Mardie Offset Research Program
- DWER: Exmouth Freshwater Cultural Values Water Mapping
- Professor Matthew Tonts: Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) Chair EPA Section 16
 (e) Exmouth Gulf advice, current Gulf area proposals before the EPA and EPA processes.
