



Infographic APP08 Apply for a Working with Children Check

Information on how to apply for a Working with Children (WWC) Check in Western Australia (WA).



Are you eligible?

Only people engaging in paid, unpaid or volunteer <u>child-related work</u>, with no exemption, can apply for a WWC Check in WA.



Pick up a form

WWC application forms are available at <u>authorised Australia Post outlets</u>.

Your organisation may be able to provide you with a form.



Provide your details

Fill in your information on the form and have your organisation sign and verify your child-related work.

Self-employed people do not need an organisation to sign their form.



Lodge at Australia Post

Lodge your completed form at an authorised Australia Post outlet. You will need your identification documents and the application fee; a passport-style photo will be taken by Australia Post when you lodge.



Your receipt lets you start work

Australia Post will give you a receipt when your form is lodged. In most cases, this lets you start or continue child-related work, while your application is assessed.
