Rapids Landing Primary School - Reduce, Reuse and Recycle



The school's approach to waste reduction and management is pervasive. Students participate in plastic-free lunches and there is a competition between classes. Teachers provide education lessons about plastic and these are incorporated into the school curriculum.

The sustainability club has introduced bins that collect soft plastic from school lunches. The plastic is used to create ecobricks which have an estimated 500 g of plastic tightly packed in bottles. Bottle lids have been repurposed by Precious Plastics and the Men's Shed to make benches for the school.
