EXEMPTION NOTICE

Environmental Protection (Controlled Waste) Regulations 2004 Part 4, Regulation 49

Exemption number CWE17/2022

In accordance with regulation 49(1), I am satisfied that:

- (a) the circumstances in which this exemption is requested are justifiable and accountable; and
- (b) the exemption will not adversely affect the operation of the Environmental Protection (Controlled Waste) Regulations 2004.

and

I HEREBY EXEMPT Water Corporation from Regulations 31(1) and 35(1) of the Environmental Protection (Controlled Waste) Regulations 2004 on the terms and conditions set out in this notice.

Activity to which this exemption applies

 When Water Corporation and drivers employed or engaged by Water Corporation are collecting waste from premises where the waste holder is not present at the time of collection.

Exempted regulations

Water Corporation is exempted from compliance with the following regulations:

Regulations 31(1) and 35(1).

Conditions of this exemption

- 1. Exemption CWE17/2022 only applies when collecting controlled waste types:
 - a. Non-toxic salts;
 - b. Sewage;
 - c. Waste from grease traps; or
 - d. Waste from mineral oils unfit for their intended use.
- 2. Water Corporation must give the waste holder a receipt setting out the information in Schedule 2 Division 1 of the Environmental Protection (Controlled Waste) Regulations 2004 within 14 days of the controlled waste being collected from the waste holder's premises.

In accordance with subregulation 49(2E) if a condition of this exemption notice is breached, the exemption ceases to have effect.

Reasons for Granting of this exemption

- 1. The circumstances in which this exemption is requested are justifiable and accountable.
- 2. The exemption will not adversely affect the operation of these Regulations.

Period of Exemption

This exemption begins on the date of this notice and ends on 30 June 2025.

Revocation or Variation

In accordance with subregulation 49(2) this exemption notice may be revoked or varied by me at any time by written notice.
