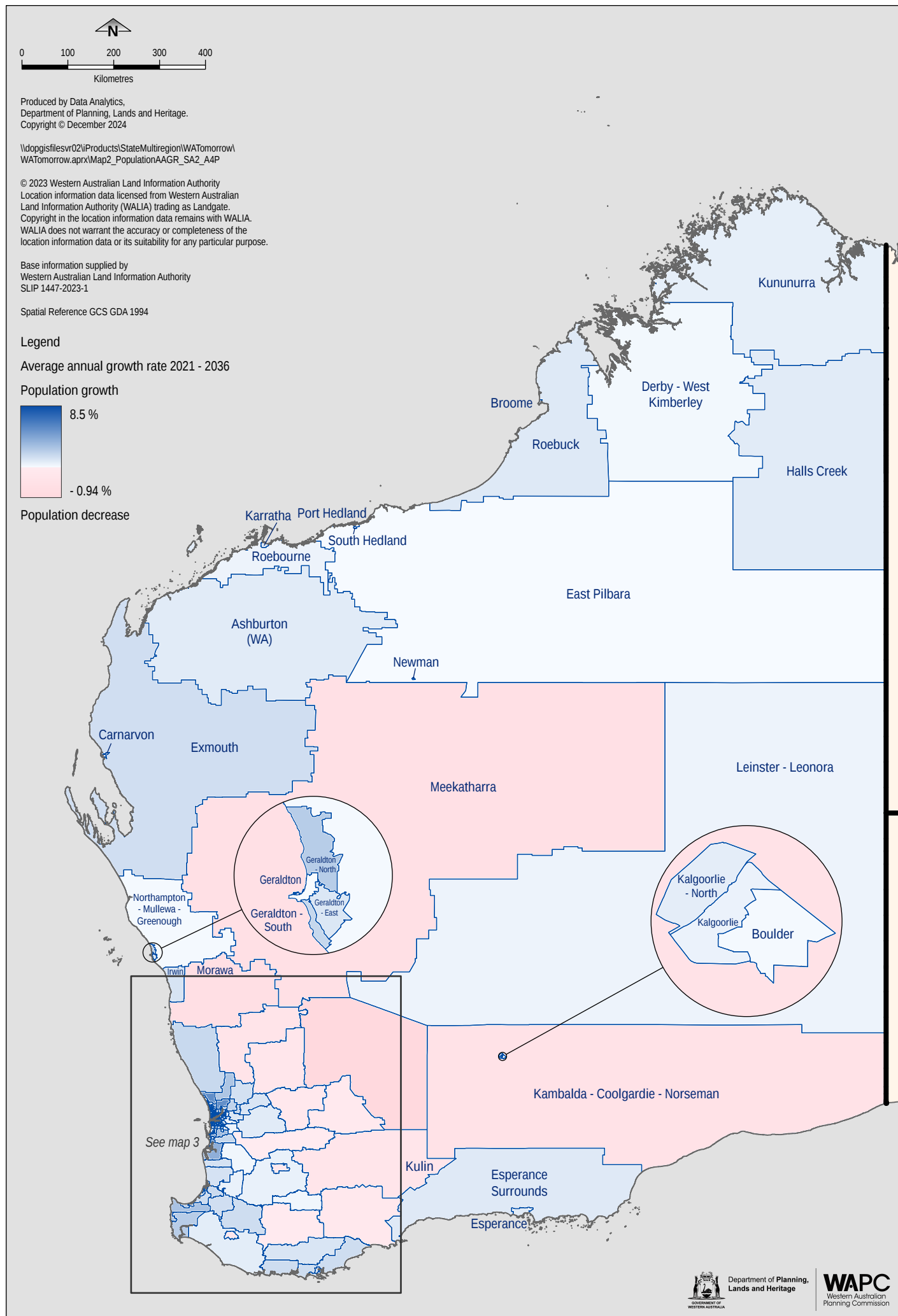
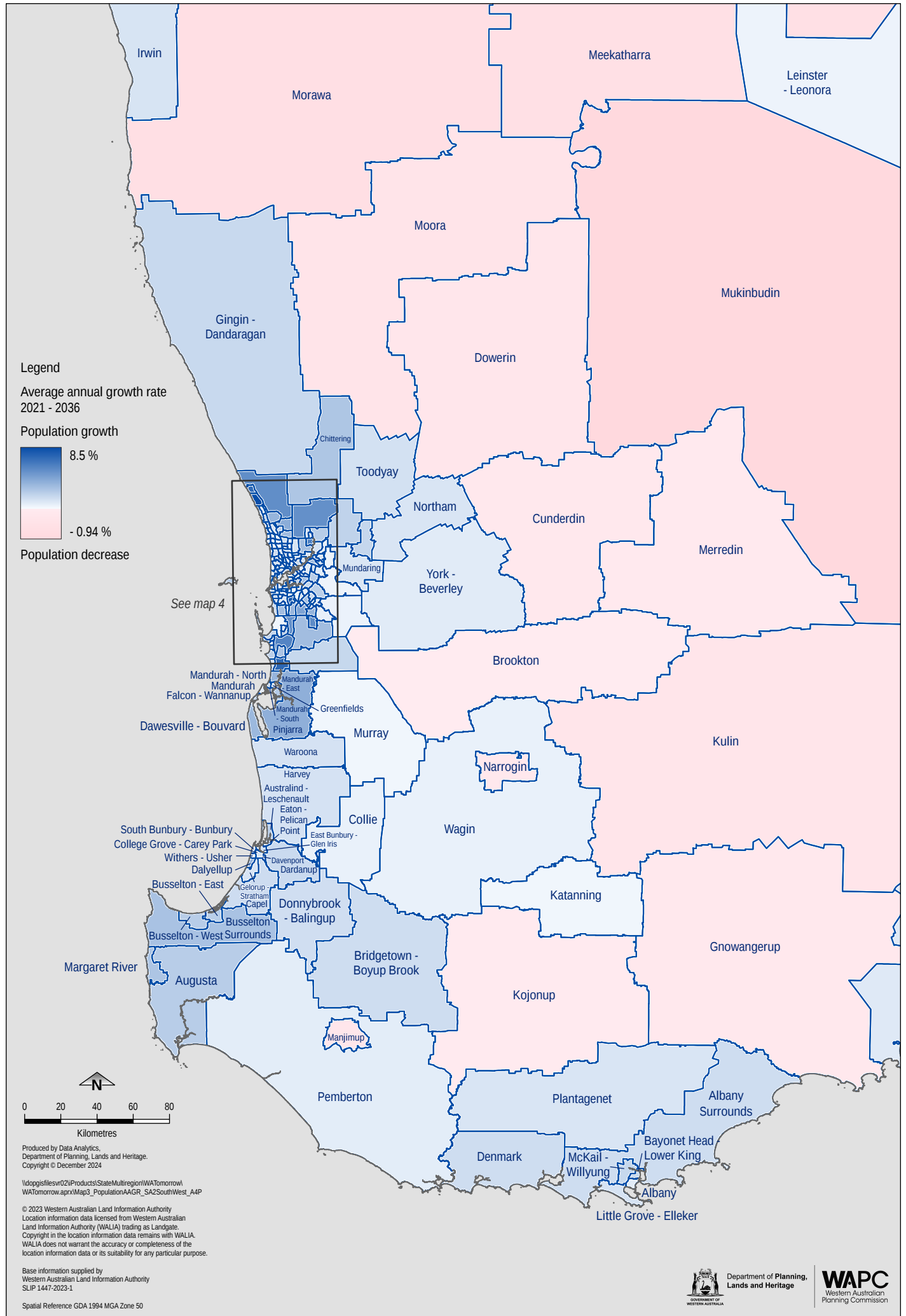


WA Tomorrow No. 12 - Average annual growth rate by Statistical Area Level 2 - 2021 to 2036

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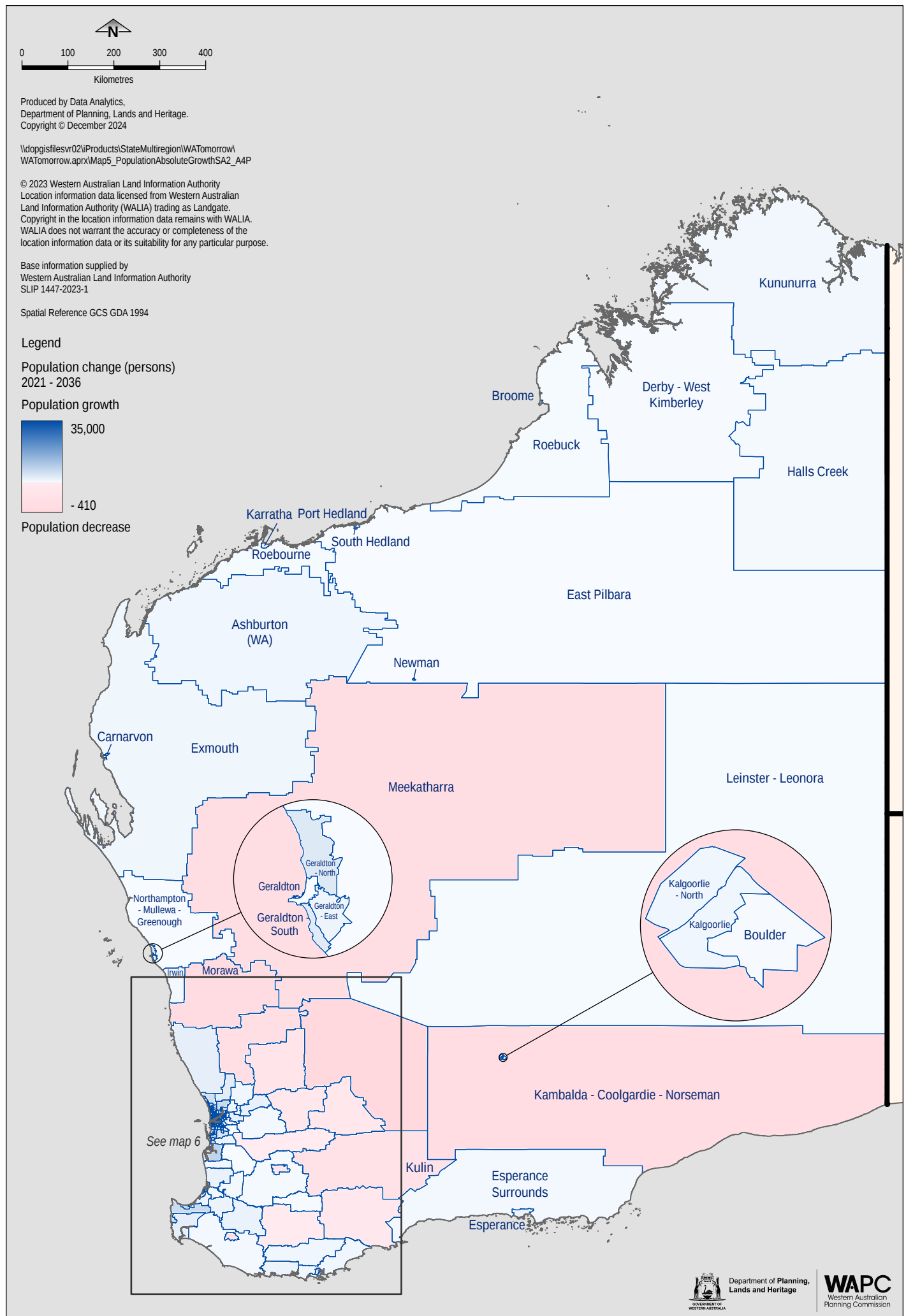

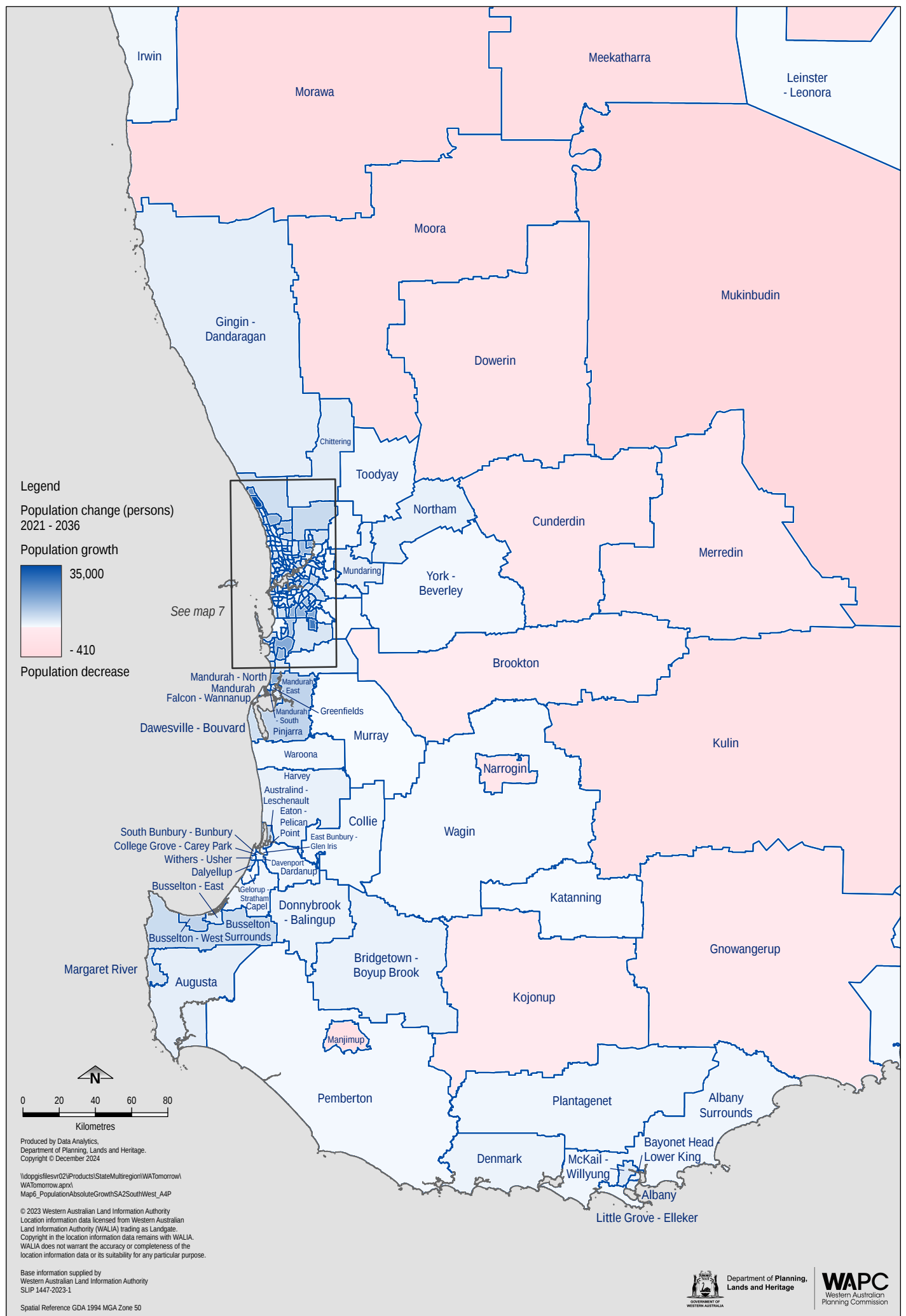
