



Office of Digital Government Direction 02 – 2025

Restrictions on the use of Kaspersky Lab Inc. products and web services

Overview

This direction requires WA Government entities to manage the risks arising from Kaspersky Lab Inc products and web services and aligns with the [direction issued by the Commonwealth Government under the Protective Security Policy Framework](#). Entities should take the necessary steps to ensure they implement the requirements of this direction as soon as practicable.

Scope

This direction applies to WA Government entities captured by the scope of the [WA Government Cyber Security Policy](#).

Position

WA Government entities are required to prevent the access, use or installation of Kaspersky Lab Inc. products and web services on WA Government devices (e.g. phones, tablets or computers). Existing instances of Kaspersky Lab Inc. products and web services on WA Government systems and devices must be removed.

Reporting

WA Government entities are required to report their compliance with this direction to the Office of Digital Government - Cyber Security Unit at cyber.policy@dpc.wa.gov.au by Wednesday 19 March 2025.
