<u>Djookanup - 16 Parkland Road, Osborne Park</u>

Opening Hours: 8:00am – 5:00pm Monday - Friday

Public access is via the ground floor reception area.



Accessibility features:

- Accessible entrance to building
- Staffed reception
- Accessible bathrooms

- Accessible meeting rooms
- ACROD parking available

Potential access barriers:

 Some people may require assistance to open the large glass doors leading from the foyer to the bathrooms

Public transport options:

- Catch the train on the Yanchep line and get off at Glendalough Station
- From the Glendalough Station, it is a 10-15 walk (just over 1km) to Djookanup, or you can catch bus route 407
- Bus route 85 also runs along Harborne Street, which is a short walk from the Djookanup building
- Visit the Transperth website for more information on public transport options.

Parking options:

- ACROD parking is available in the visitor car park off Parkland Road. Contact the panel chair if you require use of this visitor bay.
- Paid parking is available along Parkland Road and surrounding streets.
- Google Maps provides more information on parking options available around the building.




Prospect Place - 1 Prospect Place, West Perth

- Accessible entrance to building
- Staffed reception
- Accessible bathrooms

- Accessible meeting rooms
- ACROD parking available

Potential access barriers:

- Some people may require assistance to open the doors leading to the bathrooms
- Some people may require assistance to locate the ramp leading from the carpark to the front entrance

Public transport options:

- Bus services run via Fitzgerald, Charles and Newcastle Streets.
- The Leederville train station is located approximately 1.5kms away and the Perth train and bus stations are approximately 1.8kms away.

Parking options:

- ACROD parking is available outside the reception area.
- Free parking is available for visitors and clients opposite the main reception area, accessible via either Prospect Place or Colvin Place, or around the building near the Newcastle Street and Charles Street entrances.
- The building can be accessed via the entrance off Newcastle Street, via Colvin Lane off Strathcona Street, or via Charles Street when travelling north.
