The Taskforce was established following the <u>State Government's 2021 commitment</u> to enhance the protections for Exmouth Gulf and adopting the <u>EPA's Section 16(e) recommendations</u>. The <u>Taskforce Interim Report</u> to the Minister for the Environment was published in 2024.
