

SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975

DETERMINATION VARIATION

PREAMBLE

The Salaries and Allowances Tribunal has issued a variation to the *Members of Parliament Determination No. 2 of 2024* in relation to the qualifying requirements for the Perth Accommodation Allowance.

After the recent MPs review conducted by the Tribunal, the qualifying requirements for Members accessing the Perth Accommodation Allowance (PAA) was restricted to a primary residence located within the non-metropolitan district within which a Member was elected.

The Tribunal has received a request from the administering authority to alter the qualifying requirements for non-metropolitan Legislative Assembly Members to include a primary residence located within an adjacent non-metropolitan district.

The Tribunal has therefore decided to expand the qualifying requirement for Members to have access to the PAA if their primary residence is either within or in an adjacent non-metropolitan district.

DETERMINATION

The *Members of Parliament Determination No.2 of 2024* made by the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal on 17 December 2024 under sections 6(1)(a), (ab) and (b) of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below, with effect on and from the dates specified in Part 1.2 of the determination.

Delete Part 5.1(6)(a)(i) and insert the following:

for Legislative Assembly Members – in their non-metropolitan District or in an adjacent non-metropolitan District listed in Schedule 1.
