



Written consent form for tattooing or branding a child 16 years of age or older

Please note that under section 103 of the Children and Community Services Act 2004:

- A person must not in any manner tattoo or brand any part of the body of a child who has not reached 16 years of age. The penalty for breach of section 103(1) is a fine of \$12,000 and imprisonment for one year.
- A person must not in any manner tattoo or brand any part of the body of a child who has reached 16 years of age unless the person has first obtained the written consent of a parent of the child to tattoo or brand the child in that manner and on that part of the child's body. The penalty for breach of s.103(2) is a fine of \$12,000 and imprisonment for one year.
- Section 103 does not apply to tattooing or branding carried out for a medical or therapeutic purpose.
