Pilbara ISOCO's subchapter 10.1 functions – Long-term Coordination and Planning

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Energy Policy WA's Draft Decision on the Pilbara ISOCO's proposed rule change to defer subchapter 10.1 functions related to the long-term coordination and planning of the North West Interconnected System.

Consistent with our submission the initial consultation, APA supports delaying the requirement for the Pilbara ISOCO to prepare and publish the Transmission Development Plan and the Pilbara Generation Statement of Opportunities on the basis that the information.

We do not consider the information that would be published in these reports is necessarily duplicative of the work conducted by Energy Policy WA. However, we do not consider the information, if published, would add value in the current environment where Energy Policy WA has announced designated priority corridors for common-user infrastructure and is consulting on a significant reform package for the Pilbara.
