The 10th meeting of the Exmouth Gulf Taskforce (the Taskforce) was held at Joondalup on 3 December 2024. The meeting was chaired by Mr David McFerran, Taskforce Chair.

The Taskforce discussed a range of topics, including:

- Dr Jenny Shaw, Research Director, Western Australian Marine Science Institution provided an update on the knowledge review reporting and prioritisation survey.
- Rebecca Bateman and Karissa Lear presented on sawfish, their lifecycle and prevalence in the Exmouth Gulf.
- Draft final Taskforce recommendations, advice and reporting requirements to fulfill its
 Terms of Reference to the Minister to Environment.
