

SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975

DETERMINATION VARIATION

PREAMBLE

The Salaries and Allowances Tribunal has issued a variation to the *Members of Parliament Determination No. 1 of 2025* to clarify the basis of the Transition Allowance.

The Transition Allowance is to be calculated with reference to the base remuneration of a Member of Parliament, with the final amount dependent on the qualifying period. The intention is that the relevant figure used is the base remuneration applicable on the day the Member ceases to be a Member of Parliament.

This variation makes the above intent clear in the determination.

DETERMINATION

The *Members of Parliament Determination No.1 of 2025* made by the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal on 20 June 2025 under sections 6(1)(a), (ab), (b) and 6AA of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below, with effect on and from 1 July 2025.

Delete Part 7.1(5) and insert the following:

The maximum amount of the Allowance is a proportion of the Base Remuneration as at the time of ceasing to be a Member of Parliament, calculated according to a Member's length of service as a Member, as stated in Table 6.
