The purpose of the common branding signage is to inform the community about State Government capital works projects under construction, including both building and infrastructure works.

Signage design templates are provided in the *Signage Guidelines Capital Works* document to ensure a consistent appearance. The signage artwork is part of a broader style guide for the State Government communications.

Scope of Operation and Timing:

This procurement direction is issued under the *Procurement Act 2020* by the Deputy Director General, Advisory Services, Department of Finance, as delegate of the Minister administering the *Procurement Act 2020*.

This procurement direction is issued to all State agencies and applies on and from 12 August 2021.

Government Trading Enterprises are also encouraged to apply this direction.

State agencies must install common branding signs at the sites of capital works projects in accordance with the requirements of the *Signage Guidelines Capital Works*, which can be found at https://www.wa.gov.au/government/publications/signage-guidelines-capital-works.

State agencies must ensure signage proposals are approved by the Department of Finance before commencing manufacture of the signs. Unique signage arrangements may be warranted for highly significant projects or those with joint funding arrangements involving the State and Commonwealth. In such circumstances, State agencies should seek advice from the Department of Finance before commencing the design.
