This procurement direction seeks to increase awareness and understanding of supplier legislative obligations relating to gender equality.

General Procurement Direction: 2024/02

Inclusion of Disclosure Clause

State agencies **must** include a gender equality in procurement disclosure clause in all goods, services, works and community services approach to market documents for procurements with an estimated contract value of \$250,000 and above.

The disclosure clause must be in the form published by the Department of Finance, available in the Gender Equality in Procurement – Disclosure Clause document published on <u>wa.gov.au</u>.

Supporting information

The disclosure clause asks potential suppliers to disclose whether they comply with their applicable legislative obligations, and in doing so seeks to increase awareness and understanding of these obligations.
