Meeting held Friday 13 June 2025

This communique highlights key discussions and considerations from the Road Safety Council (Council) meeting held on Friday 13 June 2025.

Chair's Report

Council noted the Chair's activities since the last meeting and agreed to hold a strategy day to focus on strategic and forward-thinking discussions.

Code of Conduct

Council approved the revised Road Safety Council Code of Conduct updated to reflect the new Code of Ethics and revised minimum standards of conduct and integrity.

Minister for Road Safety Attendance

The Chair welcomed Hon Reece Whitby, Minister for Road Safety. The Minister addressed the Council and outlined key areas of focus including implementing the Roundtable initiatives and the safety cameras program.

Road Smart Kickstart Program

The Road Safety Commission informed Council members on the Road Smart Kickstart program and its delivery into regional schools, with an approach that challenges and reshapes young persons before they commence driving.

Evaluation of Road Trauma Trust Account – Funded Programs

The Council were provided a progress update on the evaluation activities and proposed action of RTTA funded programs. The time frame to undertake data evaluation was discussed, with a focus of obtaining credible data. Council noted key evaluation findings.

Road Trauma Trust Account Progress Update

Council noted the financial and administrative status of 2024-25 RTTA funded programs and the proposed review of programs established for 2025.
