Communique – 3 June 2025

The fifth meeting of the Directors General Technology, Innovation and Science Council (TISC) was held on 3 June 2025.

The TISC considered the following matters:

WA Government Information Classification Policy

The TISC endorsed proposed updates to the WA Government Information Classification Policy (the Policy), its supporting materials and governance arrangements to strengthen alignment with the *Privacy and Responsible Information Sharing Act 2024*. By refining the Policy and establishing a more targeted forum for collaboration, the updates aim to advance the Policy's core objective. This is to enable agencies to apply appropriate security measures to protect, manage, and share their information assets. These updates are designed to provide clearer guidance to support the effective implementation of the Policy across agencies.

Government Science Project of the Year Award

The TISC discussed the efforts of the Premier's Science Awards and the WA Science Hall of Fame to raise the profile of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) within the WA Government. The awards showcase the public sector's leadership in science and innovation and its commitment to delivering better outcomes for the community.
