

SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1975

DETERMINATION VARIATION

PREAMBLE

Under section 6A of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975* and sections 28(3)(5) and (6) of the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1970*, the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal is required to make determinations in relation to the payment of benefits under the Parliamentary Pension Scheme.

On 8 March 2007, the Tribunal made a determination in relation to the splitting of superannuation interests following the end of a marital relationship. Amendments to the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1970* in 2006 allowed for the immediate splitting of superannuation. The Tribunal's 2007 determination gave effect to this provision.

The Tribunal has since been advised that the 2007 determination contains an incorrect reference to the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1970*. This variation corrects that error.

DETERMINATION

The *Determination: Superannuation for Members of Parliament – 2007 March 28th* made by the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal on 28 March 2007 under sections 6(A) of the *Salaries and Allowances Act 1975* and sections 28(3)(5) and (6) of the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1970*, as amended from time to time, is hereby varied by a determination set out below.

Delete reference to Section 18 of the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1970* and insert:

Section 19 of the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1970*
