

LGIRS Occupational Licensing Performance Report September Quarter 2025

This September quarter report highlights strong operational performance across most licensing categories. A total of 38,165 applications were finalised during the quarter, reflecting increased demand from 36,454 in the June quarter.

Our performance objective is for licensing days to be within target timelines for 80 per cent of finalised applications. This objective was met or exceeded in several categories. Plumbing licensing achieved 96 per cent finalisation within target timelines, with an average processing time of just eight business days. Gas licensing followed closely with 91 per cent finalised within target and an average of nine days. These results demonstrate the ability to maintain high-service standards despite growing application volumes, particularly under the Build a Life in WA Incentive.

Registered Building Contractor and Practitioner applications were finalised in an average of 23 business days, with 97 per cent completed within target. Painting licences averaged 21 days, with 98 per cent finalised within target, maintaining strong performance. Building Surveying applications averaged 30 days, with 94 per cent finalised within target, indicating stable but slightly extended processing times. Owner Builder applications were finalised in 26 days, with 99 per cent meeting the target timeframe.

Electrical licensing averaged 14 business days, with 63 per cent of applications finalised within the target timeframe. Although renewals were processed efficiently, delays in new applications contributed to a decline in overall performance, down from 71 per cent in the June quarter. Dangerous goods licensing experienced an increase in average processing time to 32 days, up from 20 days in the previous quarter. This also corresponds with an increase in volume causing a slight fall to 68 per cent of applications being finalised within target, representing a 27 per cent drop compared to the June quarter.

High Risk Work Licences averaged 21 days, with 40 per cent finalised within target. Motor vehicle industries improved to an average of 15 days, with 29 per cent meeting target, and Property Industries averaged 19 days with eight per cent finalised within target.


Overall, the September quarter reflects our continued commitment to service improvement, with most categories demonstrating strong alignment with benchmarks.





Per cent finalised where LGIRS licensing days within target timeline









Registered Painting Contractor and Practitioner



Dangerous Goods











Motor Vehicle Industries


Distribution of business days to finalise applications - 2025 Q3
