Fish Resources Management Act 1994

PROHIBITION ON FISHING FOR DEMERSAL SCALEFISH ORDER 2025

[LLS35727]

Made by the Minister under section 43.

1. Citation

This order is the *Prohibition on Fishing for Demersal Scalefish Order 2025*.

2. Commencement

This order comes into operation as follows –

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) clause 5 on 1 January 2026;
- (c) the rest of the order on 16 December 2025.

3. Interpretation

In this order –

charter boat has the same meaning as in the regulations;

demersal scalefish has the same meaning as in regulation 45 of the regulations;

dhufish means fish of the common name "Dhufish, West Australian" as described in the regulations;

Metropolitan area means the area described in the Schedule;

relevant authorisation means an authorisation granted under -

- (a) the West Coast Demersal Scalefish (Interim) Management Plan 2007;
- (b) the West Coast Demersal Gillnet and Demersal Longline Interim Managed Fishery Management Plan 1997; or
- (c) the Southern Demersal Gillnet and Demersal Longline Managed Fishery Management Plan 2018 that authorises fishing in zone 1 or zone 3 of that Fishery;

spearfishing means fishing with a handspear or spear gun while diving or snorkelling;

West Coast Region has the same meaning as in the regulations.

4. Prohibition on recreational fishing for demersal scalefish in the West Coast Region

- (1) A person must not engage in recreational fishing for demersal scalefish in the West Coast Region.
- (2) Subclause (1) does not apply in respect of
 - (a) a person engaging in recreational fishing by line from the shore or a structure attached to land;
 - (b) a person engaging in recreational fishing for demersal scalefish, excluding dhufish, by spearfishing from the shore or a structure attached to land;
 - (c) a person participating in a fishing tour on a charter boat outside of the Metropolitan area.

5. Prohibition on commercial fishing under a relevant authorisation

A person must not engage in commercial fishing under the authority of a relevant authorisation.

6. Revocation

The Prohibition on Fishing for Demersal Scalefish from Boats (Closed Season - West Coast Region) Order 2024 is revoked.

Schedule

Metropolitan area

All Western Australian waters bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the high water mark on the coastline of Western Australia and 31° 00.00′ south latitude; thence extending west along the geodesic to the intersection with 114° 50.43′ east longitude; thence generally south to the intersection of 31° 12.00′ south latitude and 114° 55.00′ east longitude; thence generally south to the intersection of 31° 47.00′ south latitude and 115° 01.00′ east longitude; thence generally south-east to the intersection of 31° 56.00′ south latitude and 115° 12.50′ east longitude; thence generally south-west to the intersection of 33° 00.00′ south latitude and 114° 38.15′ east longitude; thence east along the geodesic to the intersection with the high water mark on the coastline of Western Australia; thence generally north-west along the high water mark to the commencement point.
