

Request to appoint a monitor

Use this form to request the Local Government Inspector to appoint a monitor for a local government under section 8B.38 of the *Local Government Act 1995* (the Act).

Pursuant to section 8B.38(1) of the Act, a request can only be made by:

- the Mayor or President of the local government,
- the Chief Executive Officer of the local government, or
- through a resolution passed by the local government (with an absolute majority).

The Local Government Inspector will consider the request and decide whether to appoint a monitor.

The Local Government Inspector may request further information from the applicant, CEO, or the local government for the purpose of making a decision whether to appoint a monitor.

Please note that submission of this request does not guarantee that a monitor will be appointed by the Local Government Inspector.
