Uncertified copies cannot be used for official or legal purposes, such as proof of identity, and are only available from the Perth Registry Office.

Uncertified copies of original records may vary in age, quality, and legibility. They may be handwritten or typed, and image quality cannot be guaranteed.

Original records held at the Registry are confidential and are not available for viewing for family history research by members of the public or professional genealogists.

Fees

The application fee for an Uncertified copy of Birth, Death or Marriage Record is \$24.00.

No GST is payable on this application. The fee includes regular postal delivery, is non-refundable, and cannot be transferred to another application. Any new applications will incur an additional fee.

Privacy considerations and personal records

Certificates held by the Registry contain sensitive and personal information.

Note: It is an offence to make a false or misleading statement in any application or document under the *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1998*.
