



Adult adoption process

Check your eligibility

- The applicant must reside in or be domiciled in Western Australia.
- A person who is aged 18 years or over may be adopted by a step-parent, carer or relative who cared for them immediately before they turned 18 years of age.
- The potential adult adoptee must be present in Western Australia when the adoption application is filed.
- The potential adult adoptee must either be legally permitted to remain permanently in Australia or have been born in Western Australia.

Steps to follow if the applicant and prospective adult adoptee are eligible to apply

The applicant must reside in or be domiciled in Western Australia.

1. Complete the 'Adult adoption registration to receive Schedule 1 information' form and send it to Adoption Services, Department of Communities.

2. Once the registration form is received, Adoption Services will contact the relevant parties to make an appointment for the Schedule 1 information meeting.
3. After the Schedule 1 information meeting, Adoption Services will send the applicant affidavits confirming the relevant parties have been provided with the Schedule 1 information.

Adoption Services will have no further role unless requested to provide a report in relation to the proposed adoption by the Family Court of Western Australia (the Court).

4. The applicant must notify each birth parent in writing of their intention to apply.

If a birth parent is unknown, deceased or cannot be found, the applicant may apply to dispense the requirement to give this notice with a supporting affidavit.

5. The applicant must obtain the application form and other required documents from the Court and lodge the completed application with the Court. Further information on the adoption application can be accessed from the Court's website: https://www.familycourt.wa.gov.au/A/application_adoption.aspx

The *Adoption Act 1994* states:

A person who is 18 or more years of age may be adopted by a relative or a person who was a carer or step-parent of the first-mentioned person immediately before the first-mentioned person attained 18 years of age.

'Step-parent' means, in relation to a person, another person who

(a) is not a birth parent or adoptive parent of the first mentioned person; and

(b) is married to, or the de facto partner of, the first-mentioned person's birth parent or adoptive parent.

'Carer' in relation to a child, means a person with whom the child lives and who, either alone or jointly with another person, has the daily care of the child.

'Relative' in relation to a person, means the person's grandparent, sibling, uncle or aunt.
