Collie's Just Transition Plan 2026-30 builds on the initiatives and projects under way to create a strong and sustainable future for Collie as it continues to diversify its economy and shift away from a dependence on coal and coal-fired energy production. The 2026-30 Plan encompasses the change that has occurred in Collie since the transition began and provides the framework to continue the work that will help deliver a successful transition. With a focus on a five-year period, the primary goal of the Plan is supporting and creating opportunities for those affected by change in the transition from emissions-intensive industries in a coordinated way.


Strategic Focus Areas

Maximising Opportunities for Affected Workers

By ensuring workers directly affected by the planned closures are supported through change and are provided with opportunities to secure a strong career future. Reflecting that impacted workers are core to the principles of a Just Transition, this focus area aims to support pathways into new jobs by improving the understanding of the workforce, providing career advice and training support, and matching workers with emerging opportunities.

Preparing for Closure

By ensuring Collie's workforce, industry and community are well-prepared for the impacts of closure and post-closure activities, while maximising the potential economic and employment opportunities that arise during this period. Planned closures represent significant change for the Collie community, and the Just Transition Working Group recognises its role in supporting communication and community input for future planning.



Creating Industry Jobs


Through the attraction of emerging large-scale industry to Collie. This approach recognises the effort and investment required to achieve a significant structural shift in the town's industrial composition and the importance of creating long-term industry jobs to provide opportunities for the current and future workforce. It will also help Collie maintain its industrial identity and continue as an important economic hub for Western Australia.

Creating a Strong Future

By recognising that Collie's liveability and identity are important to the transition moving forward. This focus area recognises the importance of promoting Collie and its strengths to attract new industry and shape a renewed identity for the town, but also to acknowledge and celebrate the historic role of coal in Collie's community and legacy.

Creating a strong future includes recognising culture, creating meaningful economic opportunities in partnership with organisations and relevant community groups, and supporting community participation and engagement in transition.
