Members of the Roundtable bring a diverse range of experience and expertise to address system-wide issues and plan on matters of strategic importance relevant to the delivery of human services. New Members, People with Disabilities Western Australia and Financial Counsellors' Association of Western Australia, were welcomed to the Roundtable.

The Roundtable received a presentations from Members, including an update from the Council of Aboriginal Services Western Australia (CASWA) on a recent survey of its membership; and Volunteering WA's work to support improvements to volunteer screening.
